



City Manager Recommendation

Combination: Pay-as-you-go & **Bonding**



FY2007

- Levy Millage = 1/16 or .0625
- New Millage Rate = 4.9980
- Bond \$1.5 million to complete SW 2nd Avenue (annual debt service = \$120,000)
- Pay-as-you-go

 - Thomas Center Elevator Upgrade \$50,000
 Handicaped Door Electric Openers \$25,000
 - Hippodrome Elevator Upgrades \$25,000
 - Downtown Solid Waste Facility \$35,000



FY 2008

- Additional Millage Levy = 1/16 or .0625
 - New Millage Rate = 5 0605
- Pay-as-you-go
 - Thomas Center Carpet \$35,000
 - NE 19th Terrace Design \$100,000

 - 2nd Street Concept Design \$100,000 Traffic Signal NW 23rd Ave & 16th Terr \$250,000



FY 2009

- No additional millage levy
- Millage rate remains at 5 0605
- Pay-as-you-go
 - Fire Special Operations Equipment \$20,000
 - Fire Station Disinfecting Facilities \$20,000
 - Depot Avenue \$500,000
 - First of two years of funding



FY 2010

- No additional millage levy
- Bond \$3,175,000 to complete 3 projects (annual debt service = \$254,000)

 Historic Depot Building \$850,000

 Complete NE 19th Terrace \$700,000

 9 Traffic Signals \$1,625,000
- Pay-as-you-go
 - Fire station disinfecting facilities \$20,000
 - Fire Special Operations Equipment \$20,000

 - Depot Avenue \$300,000
 2nd year funding Total \$800,000



FY 2011

- No additional millage levy

 Millage rate remains at 5.0605
- Pay-as-you-go
 - Fire Special operations equipment \$40,000
 Fire Station Disinfecting Facilities \$85,000
 Public Safety Equipment \$285,213



FY 2007- 2011 Stormwater

ERU Rate increase = \$.25 each year

- ERU increase of 3% per year will also be proposed for operating

FY2007 - FY2011

- Total Millage Funded Projects=\$6,585,213
- Total SMU Projects = \$10,035,066
- Total Priority One Projects not Recommended for Funding \$21,700,000



City Commission Action

- Approve the City Manager's recommendation for the Tentative FY2007 FY2011 Capital Improvement Plan Includes funding from operating millage of
 - - .0625 mills in FY2007 forward
 Additional .0625 mills in FY2008 forward
 - Total Additional Millage = .1250 (1/8 mill)
 - Includes funding from increase in Stormwater ERU Rate
 - \$.25 each year

 - Total of \$1.25 over 5 years
 3% increase in ERU will also be proposed for operating in FY2007 & FY2008
