7 **A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF**
8 **GAINESVILLE, FLORIDA; RELATING TO THE LEVY OF**
9 **GENERAL MUNICIPAL PURPOSE AD VALOREM TAXES FOR**
10 **THE 2002-2003 FISCAL YEAR; ESTABLISHING PROPOSED**
11 **MILLAGE RATES; SETTING A PUBLIC HEARING; PROVIDING**
12 **FOR NOTICE TO THE ALACHUA COUNTY PROPERTY**
13 **APPRAISER; AND PROVIDING AN IMMEDIATE EFFECTIVE**
14 **DATE.**

17 **WHEREAS**, the Alachua County Property Appraiser certified the 2002 taxable values to
18 the City Commission of the City of Gainesville, Florida on June 14, 2002.

19 **WHEREAS**, Section 200.065, Florida Statutes, requires the City Commission to advise
20 the Property Appraiser of its rolled-back millage rate, its proposed millage rate, and of the time,
21 date, and place at which a public hearing will be held to consider the proposed millage rate and
22 the proposed tentative budget.

23 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE**
24 **CITY OF GAINESVILLE, FLORIDA:**

- 25 1. The rolled-back millage rate for general municipal purposes, as computed pursuant to
26 Section 200.065(1), Florida Statutes, is 4.6704 mills.
- 27 2. The proposed millage rate necessary to fund the proposed tentative general purpose
28 municipal budget for the City of Gainesville's 2002-2003 fiscal year is 4.9416 mills.
- 29 3. A public hearing will be held to consider the proposed millage rate and the proposed
30 tentative budget for general municipal purposes on Monday, September 9, 2002, at six o'clock

1 p.m., or as soon thereafter as the matter may be heard, in the City Hall Auditorium on the first
2 floor of City Hall, 200 East University Avenue, City of Gainesville, Florida.


3 4. The City Manager is hereby authorized and directed to provide a copy of this
4 resolution to the Alachua County Property Appraiser for use in preparing the Notice of Proposed
5 Property Taxes, as required by Section 200.069, Florida Statutes, and to execute, as the
6 Administering Official, any Department of Revenue forms necessary to complete this
7 certification.

8 5. This resolution shall take effect immediately upon its adoption.
