Recommendation

Planning Division staff recommends approval of Petition 62ZON-08PB.

Explanation

This petition requests a rezoning from an Alachua County to a City of Gainesville designation. This 6.2-acre parcel is vacant, City-owned land on Northeast 39th Avenue. See attached map for parcel location.

This area was annexed by the City in 2007, and must be brought into conformance with the City's Generalized Future Land Use Map and Generalized Zoning Map. This area is currently designated as Alachua County Rural/Agriculture land use with Agriculture (A) zoning; this petition requests a change to City of Gainesville Conservation zoning. This request is compatible with the Conservation land use requested in related petition 22LUC-08PB.

Character of the District and Suitability

This site is located on Northeast 39th Avenue near Gum Root Park, approximately three miles east of Waldo Road The site is vacant and undeveloped, and is compatible with the surrounding land use and zoning designations. The Alachua County land use designation for this site and all parcels to the south and west is Rural/Agriculture, and the County zoning is Agriculture (A). To the north and east, the City of Gainesville land use is Public Facilities and zoning is Airport facility (AF). Due to its location in the Airport Runway Clear Zone, its vacant status and its proximity to Gum Root Park, Conservation is the recommended zoning.

Conservation of the Value of Buildings and Encouraging Appropriate Land Use

There are no existing buildings on the subject property.

Applicable Portions of Current City Plans

There are no current City plans for the area.

The subject property is outside of the TCEA (Transportation Concurrency Exception Area). Future development or redevelopment of the subject property will be required to meet all applicable concurrency requirements (i.e., transportation, potable water, wastewater, stormwater management, solid waste, and recreation and open space), or sign a Proportionate Fair Share agreement for transportation concurrency.

Needs of the City for Land Areas for Specific Purposes to Serve Populations or Economic Activities

The proposed zoning is consistent with the underlying Conservation land use and will not have an effect on these considerations.

Whether there have been Substantial Changes in the Character or Development of Areas In or Near Area Under Consideration

There have been no recent developments, or changes to land use or zoning in the vicinity.

Applicable Goals, Objectives and Policies of the Comprehensive Plan

Future Land Use Element

Policy 4.1.1

Land Use Categories on the Future Land Use Map shall be defined as follows:

Conservation. This category identifies areas environmentally unsuited to urban development, permanent buffers between land uses, areas used for passive recreation and nature parks. Privately held properties within this category shall be allowed to develop at single-family densities of 1 unit per 5 acres. Land development regulations shall determine the appropriate scale of activities, structures and infrastructure that will be allowed.

Objective 4.4

Newly annexed lands shall retain land uses as designated by Alachua County until the Future Land Use Element of this Plan is amended.

Policy 4.4.1 Land use amendments shall be prepared for all annexed properties within one year of annexation.

Policy 4.4.2 Alachua County LOS standards shall apply until newly annexed lands are given land use designations in this Plan.

The proposed land use change is consistent with the 2000-2010 Gainesville Comprehensive Plan, and is recommended for approval.

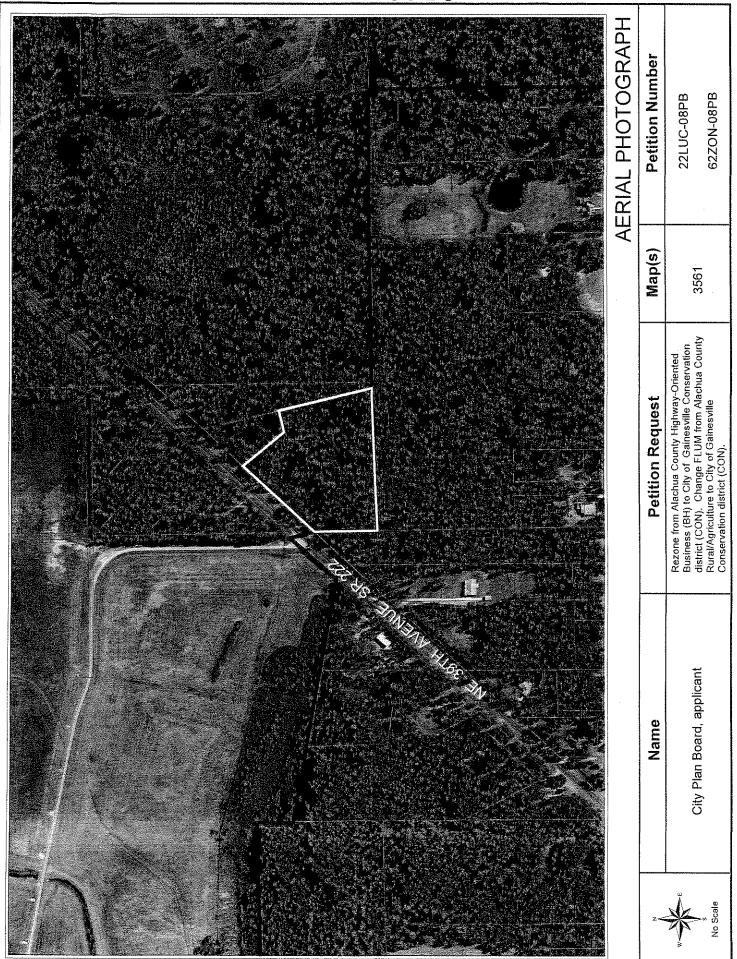
