It is understood and agreed that all of the other terms and conditions of the Grant Agreement remain in full force and effect and are not changed except as hereinabove provided.
The United States shall not be obligated under any provision hereof unless this Amendment has been accepted by the Sponsor on or before January 15, 2000 or such subsequent date as may be prescribed in writing by the FAA.
