CALL TO ORDER

The Community Development Committee meeting was called to order at 10:00 a.m.

ADOPTION OF THE AGENDA

The Community Development Committee approved the September 15, 2010 agenda subject to and modified by a request by Erik Bredfeldt, Director of Planning and Development Services, that item 090322 - Greenbelt Study for City Perimeter (B) be moved to last place on the agenda.

APPROVAL OF MINUTES

100346. Community Development Committee Minutes of July 28, 2010 (B)

The Community Development Committee approved the July 28, 2010 minutes as circulated.

Erik Bredfeldt, Director of Planning and Development Services, handed out a brief summary of action on six Community Development Committee referrals. Referrals recommended for action include the following:

090303 - Request for Consideration of Providing Wastewater Service to the City of Waldo

The Committee reviewed and received an update on this matter that the City Commission had previously taken action on at the March 4, 2010 City Commission meeting. As a consequence of Commission action, the Committee moved that this item be removed from the CDC pending referral list.

100002 - Food Stamp Program

Staff provided an update on this item regarding the City's current participation in the existing Food Stamp program and on-going work with DCF. Staff will be responding to Committee questions regarding participation rates within the City vs. the County and to services offered at a specific staff identified location. This item was recommended for removal from the CDC pending referral list.

090366 - Provide a Forum for Review: Alachua General Hospital Site
The Committee reviewed proposed plans for the redevelopment of the Alachua
General Hospital site over time in light of the existing regulatory regimen as outlined
in the University Heights Special Area Plan. The Committee heard from staff,
representatives of Shands and other interested parties. The Committee moved that
staff and Shands representatives attempt to be more flexible in approach with respect
to future proposed University Heights Special Area Plan amendments. It is
anticipated that language regarding proposed amendments will come back to the

Committee at the October regular Committee meeting. Recommendation is the Community Development Committee to City Commission: 1) the staff continues to work with Shands representatives, their agents, CRA staff and other interested parties on amending the University Heights Special Area Plan and bring back a draft to the CDC in October: 2) continue this item on the Committee's pending referral list.

080817 - Citizen Comment - Robert Pearce - Street Lights Causing Road Glare Citizen Robert Pearce provided the Committee examples of lights affixed to existing City/CRA utility poles that did not appear to adhere to City regulations. After review by the Committee, the Committee recommended the following: 1) the CRA review existing fixtures; 2) GRU review existing utility poles; 3) Code Enforcement review any outstanding Code violations; 4) Parks, Recreation and Culture review its inventory of lights; and, 5) that Building Inspections review its procedures regarding the issuance of electric permits. Recommendation is the Community Development Committee to City Commission: 1) the CRA review all existing light fixtures in the context of current City regulations; 2) GRU review all existing utility poles in the context of current City regulations; 3) Code Enforcement review any outstanding Code violations regarding lighting; 4) Parks, Recreation and Culture review its inventory of lights at various facilities in the context of current City regulations; 5) Building Inspections review its procedures regarding the issuance of electric permits for the purpose of lighting; and, 6) recommend this referral be removed from the CDC pending referral list.

090737 - Historic Preservation Issues - Referral to the CDC
Staff provided an overview of the City's Historic Preservation Program to the
Committee over time. The Committee recommended that the City Manager receive
and present additional information on the Main Street Program and that staff enter
into conversations with representatives from the College Park, Golfview and 5th
Avenue/Pleasant Street neighborhoods on the implementation of future historic
districts. Recommendation is the Community Development Committee to City
Commission: 1) the City Manager receive and present additional information to the
Commission on the applicability of the Florida Main Street Program in Gainesville;
and, 2) staff contact representatives of the College Park, Golfview and 5th
Avenue/Pleasant Street neighborhoods to inquire about the interest in implementation
of future historic districts; and, 3) recommend this referral be removed from the CDC
pending referral list.

RECOMMENDATION The Community Development Committee approve the July 28, 2010 Minutes as circulated.

090322. Greenbelt Study for City Perimeter (B)

This item involves analyzing existing plans and policies designed to establish and maintain a Greenbelt around the City of Gainesville's incorporated perimeter.

The Community Development Committee heard an overview by Erik Bredfeldt, Director of Planning and Development Services and heard detail discussion by Ralph Hilliard, Planning Manager.

Chair Hawkins, Commissioner Wells and Commissioner Donovan spoke to the matter.

MOTION: Chair Hawkins moved, with a second on the floor, to:

1) Ask GRU to incorporate some land conservation programs to mitigate impacts of its operations; 2) ask Public Works to look at our existing drainage and stormwater facilities to make them more visually attractive as well as environmentally effective; 3) GRU either retain ownership of the 121 rail or dispose of it to an appropriate environmental organization in whole; 4) Map a trail circulator of our existing green spaces and right of ways; and, 5) Remove this item from our referral list.

Commissioner Wells added to the Motion : 6) Staff is directed to come up with a green way standard.

The Motion carried by a vote of 3-0.

RECOMMENDATION The Community Development Committee review the information and provide direction to staff.
