A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF GAINESVILLE, FLORIDA; RELATING TO THE INTERLOCAL AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE CITY OF GAINESVILLE, THE ALACHUA COUNTY SHERIFF, AND ALACHUA COUNTY FOR A COMBINED COMMUNICATIONS CENTER; APPROVING THE SHERIFF'S PROPOSED FISCAL YEAR 2000 – 2001 COMBINED COMMUNICATIONS CENTER BUDGET; AUTHORIZING THE PAYMENT OF THE CITY'S SHARE OF THE COMBINED COMMUNICATIONS CENTER FISCAL YEAR 2000 – 2001 BUDGET; AND PROVIDING AN IMMEDIATE EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, on November 3, 1999, the City of Gainesville, the Alachua County Sheriff, and Alachua County, entered into an Interlocal Agreement to establish and operate a Combined Communications Center to further their mutual objectives of promoting the health, safety and general welfare of citizens throughout Alachua County by improving the efficiency and technical capabilities of emergency call taking and law enforcement, fire and emergency medical dispatch and communications services within Alachua County at a reasonable cost of such service to the general public; and

WHEREAS, the terms and conditions set forth in the Interlocal Agreement require the preparation of the a budget by the Sheriff for submission to the City Commission and County Commission, and require the approval of the initial Combined Communications Center budget prior to the commencement of operation of the Combined Communications Center by the City Commission, the Sheriff, and the County Commission; and

WHEREAS, the Sheriff is hereby submitting the initial Combined Communications Center budget for the review and approval of the City Commission, as Attachment "A".

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF GAINESVILLE, FLORIDA:

- 1. The Alachua County Sheriff's Fiscal Year 2000 20001 Combined Communications Center budget submitted as Attachment "A", is approved.
- 2. The City Manager is hereby authorized and directed to transmit payment to the County as specified in Section 3(B) of the Interlocal Agreement.
 - 3. This resolution shall become effective immediately upon adoption.
