Ordinance No. 0-06-112 Petition 112SVA-06PB

An ordinance of the City of Gainesville, Florida, to vacate, abandon and close that portion of Southwest 14th Street located in the vicinity between Southwest 12th Avenue and Southwest 13th Avenue, as more specifically described in this Ordinance; reserving public and private utilities easements; providing conditions and a reversionary interest; providing a severability clause; providing a repealing clause; and providing an immediate effective date.

Recommendation: The City Commission adopt the proposed ordinance.

#### COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT STAFF REPORT

This is a request to vacate a portion of Southwest 14th Street to facilitate the development of a cancer hospital and associated facilities.

The Plan Board's recommendation of approval of the street vacation is conditional upon the following: 1) the Special Use Permit and Site Plan for the Shands Cancer Hospital development must be approved by the City; and 2) the second reading of the ordinance approving the street vacation of a portion of Southwest 14th Street located between Southwest 12th Avenue and Southwest 13th Avenue shall be coordinated with the final sign-off of the site plans for Shands Cancer Hospital. The Plan Board at this point approved the Special Use Permit for a height of eight stories for the hospital, along with preliminary development plan approval.

Public notice was published in the Gainesville Sun on August 1, 2006. Letters were mailed to surrounding property owners on August 2, 2006. The Plan Board held a public hearing on August 17, 2006.

#### CITY ATTORNEY MEMORANDUM

The City Commission, at its meeting of September 25, 2006, authorized the City Attorney to draft and the Clerk of the Commission to advertise an ordinance vacating the public right-of-way. The vacation of the right-of-way is subject to the terms of a Vacation of Right-of-Way

Agreement between the City and the applicant. The Agreement was approved by the City Commission on November 27, 2006 and applies equally to all other street vacation ordinances relating to this Project.

14	Gainesville, an application was initiated to vacate, abandon and close that portion of Southwest						
15	14th Street located in the vicinity between Southwest 12th Avenue and Southwest 13th Avenue, as						
16	more specifically described herein to make possible the Shands Cancer Hospital development; and						
17	WHEREAS, notice was given and publication made as required by law and a public						
18	hearing was held by the City Plan Board on August 17, 2006; and						
19	WHEREAS, at least ten (10) days notice has been given of the public hearing once by						
20	publication in a newspaper of general circulation notifying the public of this proposed ordinance						
21	and of the public hearings in the City Commission meeting room, First Floor, City Hall, in the City

#### CITY OF GAINESVILLE, FLORIDA:

- 9 Section 1. Except as provided in Sections 2 and 3 below, the following described right-
- of-way in the City of Gainesville no longer serves a public purpose and is hereby vacated,
- abandoned and closed for use by the public generally in order to make possible the project,
- commonly known as "Shands Cancer Hospital":
- See legal description attached hereto as Exhibit "A", and made a part hereof
- as if set forth in full.

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- Section 2. The City reserves unto itself, its successors and assigns a public and private
- utilities easement over, under, across and through the right-of-way described in Exhibit "A",
- 17 attached hereto and made a part hereof, for the purpose of operating, maintaining, removing and
- relocating the public and private utilities located therein.
- 19 Section 3. The vacation, abandonment and closure of the right-of-way described in § 1
- of this Ordinance is subject to the terms and conditions of a certain Vacation of Right-of-Way
- 21 Agreement between the City and the applicant of the petition to vacate the right-of-way.
- 22 Southeastern Health Care Foundation, Inc., which Agreement provides, among other things, that
- 23 this ordinance may be repealed and the vacation, abandonment and closure of the right-of-way

Section 4. The Clerk of the Commission or designee is authorized to record a true copy						
The clerk of the commission of designed is authorized to record a frac copy						
of this Ordinance in the Public Records of Alachua County, Florida.						
Section 5. If any section, sentence, clause or phrase of this ordinance is held to be invalid						
or unconstitutional by any court of competent jurisdiction, then said holding shall in no way affect						
the validity of the remaining portions of this ordinance.						
Section 6. All ordinances, or parts of ordinances, in conflict herewith are to the extent of						
such conflict hereby repealed.						
Section 7. This ordinance shall become effective immediately upon final adoption.



#### LEGAL DESCRIPTION:

SOUTHWEST 14th STREET (WASHINGTON AVENUE PER PLAT) LYING BETWEEN BLOCK 2 AND BLOCK 5 OF LITTLE GANDY SUB-DIVISION AS RECORDED IN PLAT BOOK "B" PAGE 28 OF THE PUBLIC RECORDS OF ALACHUA COUNTY, FLORIDA, LOCATED IN SECTION 7, TOWNSHIP 10 SOUTH, RANGE 20 EAST, ALACHUA COUNTY, FLORIDA, BEING MORE PARTICULARLY DESCRIBED AS FOLLOWS:

BEGIN AT THE NORTHWEST CORNER OF LOT 9 OF BLOCK 2 OF SAID LITTLE GANDY SUB-DIVISION; THENCE SOUTHERLY, ALONG THE WESTERLY LINE OF SAID LOT 9 AND ALONG THE WESTERLY LINES OF LOTS 8 AND 7 OF SAID BLOCK 2 OF LITTLE GANDY SUB-DIVISION TO THE SOUTHWEST CORNER OF SAID LOT 7 OF BLOCK 2 OF LITTLE GANDY SUB-DIVISION; THENCE WESTERLY TO THE SOUTHEAST CORNER OF LOT 5 OF BLOCK 5 OF SAID LITTLE GANDY SUB-DIVISION; THENCE NORTHERLY, ALONG THE EASTERLY LINE OF SAID LOT 5 OF BLOCK 5 AND ALONG THE EASTERLY LINES OF LOTS 4, 3, 2, AND 1 OF SAID BLOCK 5 OF LITTLE GANDY SUB-DIVISION TO THE NORTHEAST CORNER OF SAID LOT 1 OF BLOCK 5 OF LITTLE GANDY SUB-DIVISION; THENCE EASTERLY TO THE POINT OF BEGINNING.
