

RESOLUTION NO. _____

PASSED: January 28, 2008

A Resolution of the City of Gainesville, Florida, authorizing the City Manager to execute a Joint Participation Agreement between the City of Gainesville and the Florida Department of Transportation to receive Service Development Funds for implementation of intelligent transportation system applications.

WHEREAS, the City of Gainesville owns and operates the public transit system serving the Gainesville urbanized area in Alachua County; and is working in cooperation with the University of Florida to on a demonstration project involving applications of Intelligent Transportation System technology to improve schedule adherence and disseminate timely bus location information to assist passengers; and

WHEREAS, the Florida Department of Transportation makes available Service Development Funds for implementation of intelligent transportation system applications; and

WHEREAS, the Florida Department of Transportation requires the execution of a Joint Participation Agreement by the CITY and the provision of matching funds; and

WHEREAS, the University of Florida has agreed to provide fifty percent of the required local matching funds.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF GAINESVILLE, FLORIDA:

Section 1. The City Manager is authorized to execute a Joint Participation Agreement (F.P. Number: 411177 5 84 08) for Service Development Funds for implementation of intelligent transportation system applications on behalf of the City of Gainesville, Florida, with the Florida Department of Transportation.

Section 2. The City Manager, within the CITY's approved budget, is authorized to provide fifty percent of the local share in conjunction with the University of Florida's fifty percent participation to match such State Block Grant Funds as may be authorized.

Section 3. This Resolution shall become effective immediately upon adoption.
