WHEREAS, the third Monday in January is recognized as a National Holiday in memory and recognition of the life, deeds and principles espoused by Dr. Martin Luther King, Jr.; and

WHEREAS, Highway 441 in Alachua County has been renamed the Martin Luther King, Jr. Highway by House Bill 230, Chapter Law 88-419; and

WHEREAS, on Monday, January 18, 2021, several programs will be held honoring Dr. King.
