CODE BACKGROUND SUMMARY

City ordinances do not specifically address the term “Food Truck” or “Food Truck Service” but include two terms "vending booth" and “itinerant food vendor” which closely parallels the food truck service. An "itinerant food vendor" is defined as “...a natural person or business entity that sells immediately consumable food products and non-alcoholic beverage items from a non-permanent cart, trailer, or vehicle at a fixed location on private property...” A "vending booth" is defined as “...a temporary wheeled cart-mounted food or retail establishment located on public property...”

Food trucks are allowed to operate within the MU-1, MU-2 and BUS zoning districts as Itinerant Food Vendors. They are also allowed to operate in association with a Special Event conducted by a business establishment at its location, once every sixty (60) days. Non-profit agencies are allowed to operate a special event within any zoning district with associated food truck services.
