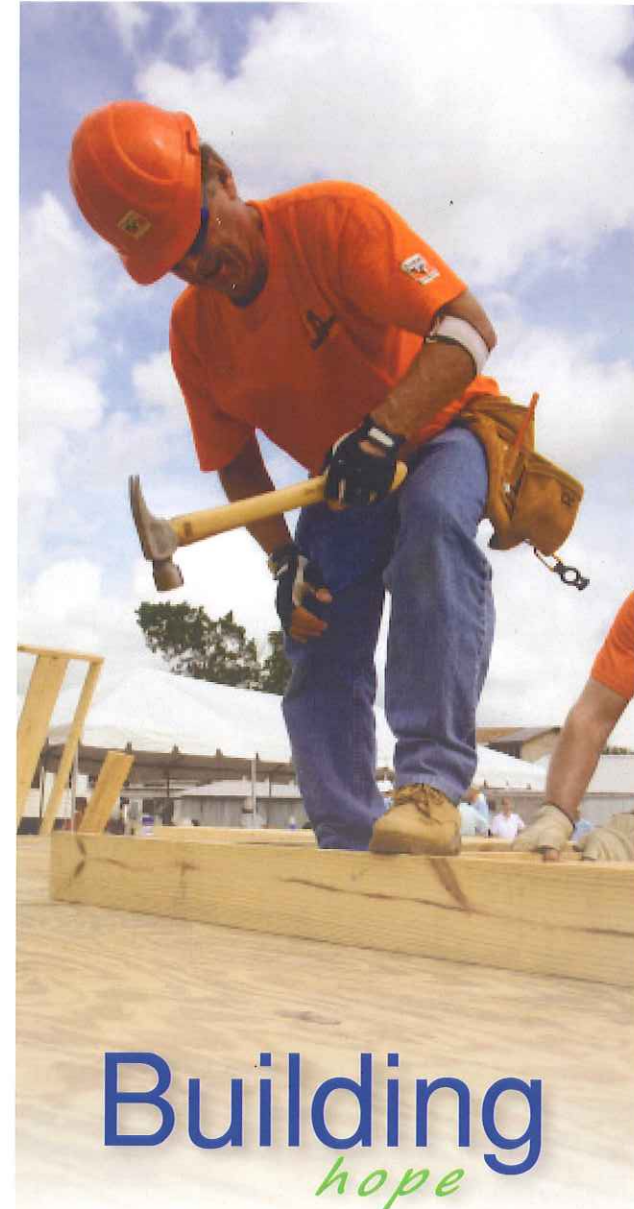

Habitat for Humanity is a nonprofit, nondenominational Christian housing ministry. Habitat welcomes all people regardless of race, religion, ethnicity or any other difference to build and repair simple, decent, affordable houses with those who lack adequate shelter.

Alachua Habitat for Humanity was founded in 1986 and continues to build affordable housing for local families in need. We select and support homeowners, organize volunteers and coordinate house building and repairs.



Who We Serve

Homeowners selected based on their need for housing, ability to repay a mortgage and willingness to work in partnership with Habitat.

How It Works

Through volunteer labor and donations of money and materials, Habitat builds and rehabilitates simple, decent houses alongside our homeowner partner families. Individuals, corporations, faith groups and other community members and organizations provide vital financial support.

In addition to a down payment and monthly mortgage payments, homeowners invest hundreds of hours of their own labor into building their Habitat house and the houses of others. Then Habitat houses are sold to partner families at no profit and financed with affordable loans. The homeowners monthly mortgage payments are used to build still more Habitat houses.
