

RESOLUTION NO. 150897

PASSED: May 5, 2016

A RESOLUTION of the City Commission of the City of Gainesville, Florida, authorizing the execution of a Joint Participation Agreement (JPA), Financial Project No. 43918518416, with the Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT) to receive FY 2015/2016 Commuter Assistance Program funds, and authorizing the City Manager or his authorized designee to execute any such applications and to otherwise act on behalf of the City of Gainesville, Florida in connection therewith.

WHEREAS, The City of Gainesville operates a public transit system, Regional Transit System (RTS), that provides service to and around the city limits; and

WHEREAS, The City Commission of the City of Gainesville, Florida, and the Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT) concur that funding be provided for a Commuter Assistance Program in a multi-county service area; and

WHEREAS, funding from the FDOT Commuter Assistance program is available for Administration and Operations of the vRide program funded at 100% of eligible unsubsidized expenditures by the Department; and

WHEREAS, a Joint Participation Agreement (JPA) is required as a basis for the City to receive funding from FDOT;

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF GAINESVILLE, FLORIDA:

1. The City Commission confirms its desire to enter into a JPA with FDOT.
2. The City Manager, or his duly appointed successor in title, or such authorized designee, is authorized to execute the JPA, including any Supplemental Joint Participation Agreements (SJPA) for the purpose of Scope Changes and/or funding adjustments, as well as execute Assurances, Certifications, and all other documents as may be required in support of the project.
3. The City Manager, or his authorized designee, is authorized to sign requests for Contract Time Extension(s), as may be required in support of the project.
4. The City Manager, or his authorized designee, is authorized to sign reimbursement requests.
