

**FIRST AMENDMENT TO AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE CITY OF
GAINESVILLE AND RECYCLING SERVICES OF AMERICA, INC. FOR PAPER
RECYCLING SERVICES SUPPORTING THE
CITY OF GAINESVILLE, FLORIDA**

THIS FIRST AMENDMENT TO AGREEMENT, hereinafter referred to as "First Amendment", made and entered into this ____ day of _____, A.D., 1999, by and between the City of Gainesville, a Florida municipal corporation, hereinafter referred to as "CITY", and Recycling Services of America, Inc., hereinafter referred to as "CONTRACTOR":

WITNESSETH:

WHEREAS, all parties hereto previously entered into an Agreement Between the City of Gainesville, and Recycling Services of America, Inc., for Paper Recycling Services hereinafter referred to as "Agreement", dated 26 September, 1997, for the collection, processing and marketing of recyclable paper products from the buildings and facilities of the City; and

WHEREAS, the parties wish to amend the Agreement.

NOW, THEREFORE, the parties hereby agree to amend the Agreement as follows:

Term of Agreement is amended in its entirety to read:

Term. This First Amendment shall begin on, October 1, 1999, and shall continue in full force and effect until, September 30, 2001. Upon successful completion of this First Amendment, as determined by the CITY, one (1) additional two-year extension may be negotiated, depending on the availability of funds.

SAVE AND EXCEPT as expressly amended herein, all other terms and provisions of the original agreement between the parties, dated 26 September 1997 shall be and remain in full force and effect.
