- **Section 1.** The Employer amends the Plan as outlined in the Employer VantageCare Retirement Health Savings (RHS) Plan Adoption Agreement, attached hereto as Exhibit "A", and by reference made a part hereof as if set forth in full below.
- **Section 2.** The City Manager or designee(s) is authorized to execute any instrument necessary to effectuate the aforementioned amendment to the Plan.
