19 **WHEREAS,** at least 10 days notice has been given once by publication in a newspaper
20 of general circulation notifying the public of this proposed ordinance and of a public hearing to
21 be held in the City Commission Auditorium, City Hall, City of Gainesville; and

22 **WHEREAS,** the Public Hearings were held pursuant to the published notice described at
23 which hearings the parties in interest and all others had an opportunity to be and were, in fact,
24 heard.

25 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE**
26 **CITY OF GAINESVILLE, FLORIDA:**

27 **Section 1.** Portions of Appendix A of the Code of Ordinances, relating to fees for Adult
28 Performance Establishment, Escort Services, and Escort Licenses; Alcoholic Beverages;
29 Alcoholic Beverage Bottle Club Licenses; Cable Franchises; Cemeteries; Controlled Vehicular
30 Parking Area Decals/Permits; Fire/Rescue Alarm Fees, Charges and Inspections; Home
31 Occupation Permits; Land Development Code Petitions, Applications and Development Fees;
32 Annual Spring Arts Festival Permits and Fees; Burglar Alarm Operators, Systems and Fees;
33 Roam Towing Fees; Secondhand Goods Dealers; Permits for use of and work in Streets,

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1 Sidewalks and Other Public Places; Business Tax Receipts; Traffic and Motor Vehicles Parking
2 Violations and Delinquent Fees; Vehicles for Hire Franchise Fees and Permits; and Vending
3 Booth and Itinerant Permit Fees, are hereby amended to read as follows:

6 **Section 2.** It is the intention of the City Commission that the provisions of Section 1 shall
7 become and be made a part of the Code of Ordinances of the City of Gainesville, Florida, and
8 that the Sections and Paragraphs of this Ordinance may be renumbered or relettered in order to
9 accomplish such intentions.

10 **Section 3.** If any section, sentence, clause or phrase of this ordinance is held to be invalid or
11 unconstitutional by any court of competent jurisdiction, then said holding shall in no way affect
12 the validity of the remaining portions of this ordinance.

13 **Section 4.** All ordinances, or parts of ordinances, in conflict herewith are to the extent of such
14 conflict hereby repealed.

15 **Section 5.** This ordinance shall take effect immediately upon adoption; provided however,
16 the fees and charges as provided for herein shall be applicable to rates and charges which are
17 due after 12:01 A.M., October 1, 2007.
