Members of the Committee discussed the information and by consensus asked staff to bring an item before the City Commission on February 19th asking that a letter be sent to the Trust for Public Land (TPL) Regional Office located in Tallahassee, Florida, requesting Technical Advice and Assistance with the Commission's Strategic Initiative 6.3 to develop a program to fund the implementation of the Master Plan.*
