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15	WHEREAS, the Governmental Accounting Standards Board has adopted Statement No.
16	54 titled Fund Balance Reporting and Governmental Fund Type Definitions which requires that
17	special revenue funds may only be used to report proceeds from specific revenue sources that are
18	restricted or committed to expenditure for specified purposes; and
19	WHEREAS, the City of Gainesville currently uses certain special revenue funds to
20	separately track and monitor the spending of revenue sources which have not previously been
21	formally restricted or committed; and
22	WHEREAS, the City of Gainesville desires to commit such revenues to certain specified
23	purposes;
24	NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE
25	CITY OF GAINESVILLE, FLORIDA:
26	Section 1. The revenues generated by certain cultural events and programs, including,
27	but not limited to, the Hoggetowne Medieval Faire, Tench building rentals, Downtown Plaza
28	events, the Downtown Festival and Art Show, Thomas Center brick enhancements, juried
29	exhibitions, the Asian Festival, the Beaux Arts Ball, and the Jazz Festival shall only be expended
30	on the costs of operating such cultural events and/or programs, including cultural facilities

1	repairs and improvements, and for administrative and overhead costs related to such cultural
2	events and programs.
3	Section 2. The revenues generated by Gainesville Police Department billable overtime
4	activities shall only be expended on the costs of providing the billable overtime, including
5	related administrative and overhead costs.
6	Section 3. The revenues generated by the Gainesville Technology Enterprise Center
7	(GTEC) shall only be expended on GTEC operations, improvements, or expansions, and
8	administrative and overhead costs related to GTEC.
9	Section 4. This Resolution shall take effect immediately upon its adoption.
