**An ordinance of the City of Gainesville, Florida, amending the City of Gainesville Code of Ordinances, relating to solid waste disposal; amending sec. 27-79(p) by removing outdated recycling goals; amending sec. 27-79.1 to remove outdated reference and clarifying term of franchise; amending sec. 27-80(a)(1) to clarify the frequency of payment of the franchise fee; amending Appendix A relating to fees for solid waste and recyclables by correcting a scrivener’s or codifier’s error and by providing for proration of franchise fees; providing directions to the codifier; providing a severability clause; providing a repealing clause; and providing an immediate effective date.**

**WHEREAS**, at least 10 days notice has been given once by publication in a newspaper of general circulation notifying the public of this proposed ordinance and of a public hearing to be held in the City Commission Auditorium, City Hall, City of Gainesville; and

**WHEREAS**, the Public Hearings were held pursuant to the published notice described at which hearings the parties in interest and all others had an opportunity to be and were, in fact, heard.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF GAINESVILLE, FLORIDA:**

**Section 1.** Sec. 27-79(p) of Article III, Division 2, commercial service and construction and demolition debris franchise, is amended to read as follows:

**Sec. 27-79. General provisions.**

(p) Each commercial franchisee shall report to the city by December 15 of each year ~~beginning in 2002~~ the percentage participation of its clients in commercial recycling and the amount of recycled material collected as a percentage of total solid waste collected from its customers for the year ending September 30. ~~Failure of the franchisee to meet the capacity~~

1 ~~goals established below for commercial recycling shall be considered a breach of the~~  
 2 ~~franchise, and the franchisee shall be subject to penalties as established by the policy adopted~~  
 3 ~~under section 27-85(a) of this Code. The following goals are established:~~

 5           **Section 2.**     Section 27-79.1, Term of franchise, is amended to read  
 6 as follows:

7 **Sec. 27-79.1. Term of franchise.**

8 ~~The term of each franchise issued on or after October 1, 1996, shall extend until 11:59 p.m.,~~  
 9 ~~September 30, 2004, unless forfeited or revoked sooner as provided herein. Any new~~  
 10 franchise issued or renewal of an existing franchise shall be by application. The term of any  
 11 new or renewal franchise shall extend until 11:59 p.m., on September 30 of each year, 2007,  
 12 unless forfeited or revoked sooner as provided herein.

1 Section 3. Section 27-80(a)(1) is amended to read as follows:

2 Sec. 27-80. Franchise fees.

3 (a) Amount of fee.

4 (1) The commercial franchisee providing commercial service shall pay as  
5 compensation to the city, for the rights and benefits granted hereunder, a  
6 monthly fee as described in Appendix A. For purposes of the calculation  
7 stated as Appendix A, gross revenues shall consist of all revenues from the  
8 sale or lease of containers, all revenues from garbage and trash collection  
9 services, all disposal billed, late fees, bad debt recoveries and other fees  
10 collected from customers, with no deductions except for bad debts actually  
11 written off.

12 Section 4. Appendix A, fees relating to solid waste and recyclables, is  
13 amended to read as follows:

8 ordinance which can be given effect without the invalid or unconstitutional provisions or  
9 application, and to this end the provisions of this ordinance are declared severable.

10           **Section 7.** All ordinances, or parts of ordinances, in conflict herewith are to the  
11 extent of such conflict hereby repealed.

12           **Section 8.** This ordinance shall take effect immediately upon adoption.
