This notice is to advise that you are not in compliance with the Insurance Requirements of Rule 15B-9.006(10) Florida Administrative Code, for the following reason(s):

Four horizontal lines for listing reasons for non-compliance.

The continued use of your wrecker service by the Florida Highway Patrol poses an immediate, serious danger to the safety of the public.

Therefore, you are hereby suspended, as of the date of this notice, from _____ District wrecker rotation list until such time as you provide proof that your company is in compliance with the insurance rules. If the required insurance coverage is not obtained and proof thereof provided to the Division on a Statement of Compliance form (HSMV 60313) within 30 calendar days of this Notice and Complaint, the wrecker operator rotation listing shall stand revoked.

You may request an informal hearing before the troop commander or request a formal hearing before a hearing officer. A written request for hearing must be received by: _____ within 21 days from the date of delivery of this notice. The failure to request a hearing will constitute an admission by default of this complaint without the need for further action by the Division. The operator may be represented at the hearing, take testimony, call and cross examine witnesses and have subpoenas issued. The undersigned certifies that this notice was hand delivered to the wrecker operator on the date shown above.

This notice is to inform you that effective _____ (date) your wrecker unit number _____ is hereby suspended for an indefinite period of time from the Florida Highway Patrol, _____ district station, Zone: _____ Class: _____, wrecker rotation list for the following reason(s):

- A) Wrecker failed to pass inspection on _____ (date) in violation of Rule 15B-9.005 Florida Administrative Code.
- B) Wrecker is inoperative.
Reason(s): _____

Your wrecker will be reinstated only after the necessary repairs have been made and the unit is inspected and approved.

The above indicated wrecker is not to be used for Florida Highway Patrol rotation wrecker calls until it has been reinstated. The use of this wrecker for rotation calls will be a violation of the Florida Highway Patrol Wrecker Rules and may result in your wrecker company being removed from the wrecker rotation list.

In the event this is the only wrecker maintained by the operator which has been approved by the Division for its class and zone of operation, the wrecker operator will be suspended immediately from the list in the zone and for the class. The suspension shall continue until such time as the wrecker successfully passes inspection and is approved for use, or the wrecker operator is removed from the list for failure to pass inspection. The wrecker operator must correct the deficiencies and request to have the wrecker re-inspected and approved within 30 days from the date of the suspension. If the wrecker has not been re-inspected and approved within the 30 day period, the wrecker operator shall be removed from the list.

Any further use of the wrecker unit constitutes an immediate, serious danger to the public safety. The wrecker operator may request an informal hearing before the troop commander or request a formal hearing before a hearing officer. A written request for hearing must be received by: _____ within 21 days from the date of delivery of this notice. The failure to request a hearing will constitute an admission by default of this complaint without the need for further action by the Division. The operator may be represented at the hearing, take testimony, call and cross-examine witnesses and have subpoenas issued. The undersigned certifies that this notice was hand delivered to the wrecker operator on the date shown above.
