15	which hearings the parties in interest and all others had an opportunity to be and were, in fact,

19	Section 1. Section 28-12 of the Gainesville Code of Ordinances is amended by amending			
20	subsection (e) to read as follows:			
21	Sec. 28-12. – Miscellaneous regulations.			
22	(e) No company or driver shall discriminate against any person or refuse to accept a			
23	passenger on the basis of their sexual orientation, race, color, gender, age, religion,			
24	national origin, religious belief, age, sex or sexual orientation marital status, disability or			
25	gender identity.
