AMENDMENT NO. 2 TO LEASE AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE CITY OF GAINESVILLE AND ALACHUA COUNTY FOR USE OF CITY OF GAINESVILLE/GRU UTILITY RIGHT-OF-WAY

This is an Amendment to that certain Lease Agreement dated June 1, 2001 by and between the CITY OF GAINESVILLE (doing business as Gainesville Regional Utilities), a municipal corporation organized and existing under the laws of the State of Florida, LESSOR (hereinafter referred to as City) and ALACHUA COUNTY, a charter and political subdivision of the State of Florida, by and through its Board of County Commissioners, LESSEE (hereinafter referred to as County).

WHEREAS, the parties wish to amend certain terms of the Lease Agreement;

THEREFORE, the parties agree as follows:

City of Gainesville, Florida

- Leased Property The City and County agree to expand the area of the leased property to include the following City property lying and being in Alachua County, Florida, to-wit:

 A 12' wide strip of land extending from SW 91st Street west 920'± being more particularly described in Exhibit "A", as attached hereto and made a part herein.
- 2. Except as specifically amended herein, the remaining terms of the Lease Agreement shall remain in full force and effect.
