

NEW YORK - Jennifer Capriati and Mary Pierce know all about the highs and lows of pro tennis.

Both have been Grand Slam tournament champions -- more than once. Both have gone significant stretches without winning any sort of fitle: Capriati recently ended her 11/2-year drought, while Pierce's dates to 2000. Both have been ranked highly and slipped out of the top 100.

Through it all, each kept her head up and slugged the ball.

Faced with a 5-1 third-set deficit Thursday at the U.S. Open against No. 22-seeded Jelena Dokic, Pierce mustered just enough power and gumption to pull out a 6-2, 6-7 (5), strokes to compile a 28-4 edge


7-6 (5) victory and reach the third round.
