CURRENT ACTION ITEMS

100008. Rebates/Incentives for Window Replacement (B)

Jamie Verschage, Senior Analyst, made a presentation which included background on the item, GRU's method of evaluation, what other utilities are doing and an explanation of the pilot program GRU recommends for window replacement rebates and incentives.

There was discussion about the difference between solar screen and window film, the \$300 per project cap and how the conservation analysts would assess the need for window replacement versus use of window film or solar screen.

MOTION:

The RUC approve staff's recommendation to implement an Energy Star window replacement pilot program at \$1.25/sq. ft. up to \$300 per project and a window film and solar screen pilot program at \$1.00/sq. ft. up to \$100 per project beginning October 1, 2011 (FY 2012). Staff will evaluate the project and if successful the programs would be budgeted on an annual basis and rolled into the portfolio of conservation programs. The RUC approve staff's recommendation to remove this item from the referral list.

RECOMMENDATION

Hear a presentation from staff regarding a window and window film energy efficiency incentive. Staff would like to run a pilot program to start October 1, 2011 that would provide rebates for energy efficient windows and window film. If the pilot is successful, it could be rolled into our current portfolio of efficiency programs in FY 12. Staff also recommends this item be removed from the referral list.
