SUBJECT:

Ordinance No. 0-05-35, Petition 159-ASVA-04PB

An ordinance of the City of Gainesville, Florida, to vacate, abandon and close that portion of Northwest 1st Avenue located between Northwest 13th Street (U.S. 441) and Northwest 14th Street; reserving a temporary utilities easement; providing a special condition; providing a severability clause; providing a repealing clause; and

providing an effective date.

Recommendation: The City Commission adopt the proposed ordinance.

STAFF REPORT

The petitioner is proposing the redevelopment of a three-block area in the southeast corner of the College Park Special Area District, located between University Avenue and Northwest 3rd Avenue and between Northwest 13th Street (US 441) and Northwest 14th Street. The three-block area has been assembled for purchase by the petitioner for the purpose of developing a mixeduse project, consisting of commercial, office, place of religious assembly and residential uses, to be known as "University Corners."

The petitioner is proposing to vacate, abandon, and close a portion of Northwest 1st Avenue located between Northwest 13th Street (US 441) and Northwest 14th Street. In addition, the request is to vacate, and abandon that portion of Northwest 2nd Avenue, located between Northwest 13th Street (US 441) and Northwest 14th Street. The proposal is not to physically "close" Northwest 2nd Avenue to through-traffic, however, it is to "one-way" the eastern portion of the street from Northwest 13th Street (US 441). Northwest 2nd Avenue will become a "private" street, open to the public ingress and egress.

The two streets for which a vacation is requested are minor local streets that are no more than two blocks in length. Northwest 1st Avenue is located very close to University Avenue and because of the amount of traffic generated in the area, this street has always been underutilized and has created dangerous circulation problems for both pedestrians and vehicles trying to enter, exit, or cross Northwest 1st Avenue at Northwest 13th Street (US 441).

The City shall retain temporary public and private utilities easements over, under, across, and through the vacated right-of-ways. The exact location of any new easements or a blanket easement for the entire 3-block site shall be determined at the time of site plan approval of the mixed-use development.

The Plan Board heard the petition and recommended that it be approved.

Public notice was published in the Gainesville Sun on November 2, 2004. Letters were mailed to surrounding property owners on November 3, 2004. The Plan Board held a public hearing November 18, 2004.

CITY ATTORNEY MEMORANDUM

The City Commission, at its meeting of December 13, 2004, approved the petition and authorized the City Attorney to draft the proposed ordinance for street vacation.

12	WHEREAS, pursuant to Section 30-192 of the Code of Ordinances of the City of
13	Gainesville, an application was initiated to vacate, abandon and close that portion of Northwest
14	1st Avenue located between Northwest 13th Street (U.S. 441) and Northwest 14th Street, as more
15	specifically described herein; and
16	WHEREAS, notice was given and publication made as required by law and a public
17	hearing was held by the City Plan Board on November 18, 2004; and
18	WHEREAS, at least ten (10) days notice has been given of the public hearing once by
19	publication in a newspaper of general circulation notifying the public of this proposed ordinance
20	and of the public hearings in the City Commission meeting room, First Floor, City Hall, in the
21	City of Gainesville; and
22	WHEREAS, notice has also been given by mail to all owners of property abutting the
23	portion to be vacated prior to the adoption of this ordinance; and
24	WHEREAS, prior to the public hearings the application was presented to and approved
25	by the appropriate Departments of the City; and
26	WHEREAS, the City Commission finds that it is in the public interest to vacate;

1	abandon and close the area for the purpose of accommodating a planned development, commonly
2	known as University Corners, subject to a temporary utilities easement.
3	NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE
4	CITY OF GAINESVILLE, FLORIDA:
5	Section 1. Except as provided in Section 2 and 3 below, the following described right-of-
6	way in the City of Gainesville no longer serves a public purpose and is hereby vacated,
7	abandoned and closed for use by the public generally in order to make possible the planned
8	development, commonly known as University Corners (Ordinance No. 040657):
9	See Legal Description attached hereto as Exhibit "A", and made a part hereof as if set forth in full.
11	Section 2. The City reserves unto itself, its successors and assigns a temporary public
12	and private utilities easement over, under, across and through the right-of-way described in
13	Exhibit "A", attached hereto and made a part hereof, for the purpose of operating, maintaining,
14	removing and relocating the public and private utilities located therein. Said temporary easement
15	will expire at such time as all private and public utilities located therein are relocated from the
16	right-of-way described in Exhibit "A".
17	Section 3. In the event the planned development, commonly known as University
18	Corners, is not adopted by Ordinance No. 040657, or the planned development is not constructed
19	and completed as provided in said Ordinance, then this Ordinance may be repealed and the
20	vacation, abandonment and closure of the right-of-way shall be of no further force and effect.
21	Section 4. The Clerk of the Commission or designee is authorized to record a true copy
22	of this Ordinance in the Public Records of Alachua County, Florida.

Section 5. If any section, sentence, clause or phrase of this ordinance is held to be invalid

1	or unconstitutional by any court of competent jurisdiction, then said holding shall in no way		
2	affect the validity of the remaining portions of this ordinance.		
3	Section 6. All ordinances, or parts of ordinances, in conflict herewith are to the extent of		
4	such conflict hereby repealed.		
5	Section 7. This ordinance shall become effective immediately upon passage; however		
6	the vacation of the right-of-way shall not take effect until and unless the amendment to the City		
7	of Gainesville 2000-2010 Comprehensive Plan adopted by Ordinance No. 040656 becomes		
8	effective as provided in Section 9 of said Ordinance.

Exhibit "A" UNIVERSITY CORNERS

NW 1st Avenue Street Vacation

LEGAL DESCRIPTION:

An area of land located in Section 6, Township 10 South, Range 20 East, and further described as:

Commence at a nail and disk, P.L.S. #4788 located at the intersection of the centerline of NW 1st Avenue and the eastern right of way line of NW 14th Street and the Point of Beginning, run North 00° 28' 45" West, along said eastern right of way line, a distance 20.01 feet to the northern right of way line of said NW 1st Avenue; thence run North 89° 35' 20" East, along said northern right of way line, a distance of 298.23 feet; thence continuing along said northern right of way line, run North 63° 45' 05" East, a distance of 22.90 feet to the western right of way line of NW 13th Street; thence run South 03° 06' 06" West, a distance of 60.00 feet, to the southern right of way line of NW 1st Avenue; thence run North 63° 11' 03" West, along said southern right of way line, run South 89° 34' 19" West, a distance of 295.73 feet to the eastern right of way line, run South 89° 34' 19" West, a distance of 295.73 feet to the eastern right of way line, a distance of 20.01 feet to the Point of Beginning.
