14	WHEREAS, at least ten (10) days notice has been given of the public hearings once
15	by publication in a newspaper of general circulation notifying the public of this proposed
16	ordinance and of the public hearings in the City Commission meeting room, first floor, City
17	Hall, City of Gainesville; and
18	WHEREAS, the public hearings were held pursuant to the published notices
19	described above at which hearings the parties in interest and all others had an opportunity
20	to be and were, in fact, heard.
21	NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY

- 2. Minimum Monthly Bill. The minimum monthly bill shall be equal to the customer charge plus a minimum billing volume of natural gas as specified in the contract interruptible service contract.
- 3. Purchased gas adjustment. (see Section 27-273)
- 4. Make-up gas. If, in any month, the consumer does not take the minimum monthly quantity and as a consequence is required to pay the sum of the non-fuel energy charge and the manufactured gas plant cost recovery factor for natural gas not taken, then and in that event, the consumer shall be entitled to receive from the City without payment of a further non-fuel energy charge and manufactured gas plant cost recovery factor, at any time within the subsequent eleven (11) months, a quantity of make-up gas equal to the quantity paid for but not taken; provided, however, that consumer shall be entitled to receive make-up gas in a subsequent month only if and to the extent that the consumer has actually taken natural gas (excluding any natural gas taken in violation of an interruption or curtailment order) in excess of the minimum monthly quantity during such subsequent month. The minimum monthly quantity shall in each subsequent month be the first natural gas taken. Consumer shall pay the Purchased Gas Adjustment charge applicable to such make-up gas at the time it is taken.

5. Availability. This service is available to consumers in the natural gas service area both within and outside the corporate limits of the City:

who have completed and submitted a Contract Interruptible Service Affidavit and Agreement form specifying their adjusted current cost of alternative fuel.

1	Such forms shall be submitted monthly, on the first day of each month, and
2	anytime there is a change to information contained in a form previously
3	submitted; and,
4	(iii) only to the extent that supplies are available for this service under the City's
5	service contracts with its suppliers.
6	
7	The city reserves the right, upon twenty-four (24) hours notice to the consumer and
8	in the sole discretion of the general manager for utilities or his/her designee, to
9	discontinue service under this rate classification or to discontinue the contract rate
10	and to offer the consumer an increased contract rate, not to exceed the current
11	non-fuel energy charge for interruptible service.
12	
13	f. Large volume interruptible service rates (§27-272):
14	
15	1. Base rate. The rates to be charged and collected for natural gas sales on an
16	interruptible basis furnished by the City to consumers for large volume interruptible
17	service are hereby fixed as follows:
18	(i) Customer charge, per month, per bill rendered
19	(ii) Energy charge, per therm\$ 0.10486 <u>0.120</u>
20	(iii) Manufactured gas plant cost recovery factor, per therm \$ 0.0321
21	
22	2. Minimum Monthly Bill. The minimum monthly bill shall be equal to the customer
23	charge plus the minimum monthly quantity of 790,000 therms times the rate per
24	therm, excluding the Purchased Gas Adjustment, and shall apply to each billing or
25	portion thereof.

- 4. Make-up gas. If, in any month, the consumer does not take the minimum monthly quantity and as a consequence is required to pay the sum of the non-fuel energy charge and the manufactured gas plant cost recovery factor for natural gas not taken, then and in that event, the consumer shall be entitled to receive from the City without payment of a further non-fuel energy charge and manufactured gas plant cost recovery factor, at any time within the subsequent eleven (11) months, a quantity of make-up gas equal to the quantity paid for but not taken; provided, however, that consumer shall be entitled to receive make-up gas in a subsequent month only if and to the extent that the consumer has actually taken natural gas (excluding any natural gas taken in violation of an interruption or curtailment order) in excess of the minimum monthly quantity during such subsequent month. The minimum monthly quantity shall in each subsequent month be the first natural gas taken. Consumer shall pay the Purchased Gas Adjustment charge applicable to such make-up gas at the time it is taken.
- 5. Availability. This service is available to consumers in the natural gas service area both within and outside the corporate limits of the City who have executed a Large Volume Interruptible Gas Service Contract with the City and only to the extent that supplies are available for this service under the City's service contracts with its suppliers.
- g. Liquid propane gas service rates (§27-288.1):
 - 1. Base rate. The rates to be charged and collected for liquid propane gas sales furnished by the City to consumers are hereby fixed as follows:

1	(i) Customer charge, per month, per bill rendered
2	(ii) Energy charge (Non-fuel), per gallon. A contract rate which shall equal the
3	sum of the current non-fuel energy charge for residential natural gas
4	customers and one of the following fixed charges as determined by the
5	general manager for utilities or his/her designee:
6	A. Three-year recovery, per gallon\$ 0.15
7	B. Five-year recovery, per gallon\$ 0.10
8	C. Seven-year recovery, per gallon \$ 0.075
9	D. More than seven-year recovery, per gallon \$ 0.03

12	2. Minimum Monthly Bill. The minimum monthly bill shall be equal to the
