A Resolution of the City Commission of the City of Gainesville, Florida, authorizing the City Manager or designee, on behalf of the City of Gainesville, to enter into a Memorandum of Agreement with the Florida Department of Transportation for the purpose of maintaining certain improvements within a portion of the 6th Street Rail Corridor from SW 2nd Avenue to NW 10th Avenue.

WHEREAS, The City of Gainesville (hereinafter “City”) has the authority to enter into an agreement with the Florida Department of Transportation (hereinafter “FDOT”) for the purpose of maintaining certain infrastructure on the 6th Street Rail Corridor; and,

WHEREAS, The City desires to have certain amenities installed along rail corridors within the City; and

WHEREAS, The FDOT requires that all infrastructure installed with FDOT funds shall be maintained by the installing governmental agency; and

WHEREAS, The City desires to have the Bicycle Path/Trail installed along a certain portion of the 6th Street Rail Corridor in accordance with the attached Memorandum of Agreement.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF GAINESVILLE THAT:

1. The above recital is true and correct and incorporated herein as if fully set forth in the body of this Resolution.
2. This Resolution applies to the above referenced Memorandum of Agreement.
3. The City Manager or designee is hereby authorized on behalf of the City to sign the above referenced Memorandum of Agreement and all subsequent amendments and agreements on the subject corridor.

The foregoing Resolution was DULY PASSED, ADOPTED and became EFFECTIVE at a duly called and convened meeting of the City Commission of the City of Gainesville held on the ___ day of _____ 2011.
