An ordinance amending the City of Gainesville 2000-2010 Comprehensive Plan, Future Land Use Map; by changing the land use categories of certain properties from the land use categories of "Residential Medium-Density (8-30 units per acre)", "Residential High-Density (8-100 units per acre)", "Mixed-Use Residential (up to 75 units per acre)", "Mixed-Use Low-Intensity (8-30 units per acre), "Mixed-Use Medium-Intensity (12-30 units per acre)", "Office", "Commercial", "Education", "Public Facilities", "Conservation", and "Planned Use District", as more specifically described in this Ordinance, to "Urban Mixed-Use 1 (UMU-1: Up to 75 units/acre)" and "Urban Mixed-Use 2 (UMU-2: Up to 100 units/acre)", as more specifically described in this Ordinance; the affected properties are located within that area generally described as the area bounded by NW 5th Avenue to the north, SW 6th Street to the east, and SW 16th Avenue to the south and NW 20th Street to the west; providing directions to the city manager; providing a severability clause; providing a repealing clause; and providing an effective date.

WHEREAS, publication of notice of a public hearing was given that the Future Land Use
Map be amended by changing the land use categories of certain properties from the land use
categories of "Residential Medium-Density (8-30 units per acre)", "Residential High-Density (8100 units per acre)", "Mixed-Use Residential (up to 75 units per acre)", "Mixed-Use Low-Intensity
(8-30 units per acre)", "Mixed-Use Medium-Intensity (12-30 units per acre)", "Office",
"Commercial", "Education", "Public Facilities", "Conservation", and "Planned Use District", as
more specifically described in this Ordinance, to "Urban Mixed-Use 1 (UMU-1: Up to 75
units/acre)" and "Urban Mixed-Use 2 (UMU-2: Up to 100 units/acre)"; creating and adding a new
land use map entitled "Urban Mixed-Use District" to identify properties with the land use category

- WHEREAS, notice by the Plan Board was given and publication made as required by law
- 4 and a public hearing was held by the City Plan Board on May 19, 2005; and
- 5 WHEREAS, notice was given and public was made as required by law of the City
- 6 Commission's public hearing on this petition on June 13, 2005; and
- WHEREAS, pursuant to law, an advertisement no less than two columns wide by 10
- 8 inches long was placed in a newspaper of general circulation notifying the public of this proposed
- ordinance and of the Public Hearing to be held in the City Commission Meeting Room, First Floor,
- 10 City Hall, in the City of Gainesville at least seven (7) days after the day the first advertisement was
- 11 published; and
- WHEREAS, pursuant to law, after the public hearing at the transmittal stage, the City of
- 13 Gainesville transmitted copies of this proposed change to the State Land Planning Agency; and
- 14 WHEREAS, a second advertisement no less than two columns wide by 10 inches long was
- 15 placed in the aforesaid newspaper notifying the public of the second Public Hearing to be held at
- the adoption stage at least five (5) days after the day the second advertisement was published; and
- WHEREAS, public hearings were held pursuant to the published notice described above at
- which hearing the parties in interest and all others had an opportunity to be and were, in fact, heard;

- 20 WHEREAS, prior to adoption of this ordinance, the City Commission has considered the
- 21 comments, recommendations and objections, if any, of the State Land Planning Agency.

## NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE

## 2 CITY OF GAINESVILLE, FLORIDA:

- Section 1. The Future Land Use Map of the City of Gainesville 2000-2010 Comprehensive
- 4 Plan is amended by changing the land use categories of the following described properties from the
- 5 land use categories of "Residential Medium-Density (8-30 units per acre)", "Residential High-
- 6 Density (8-100 units per acre)", "Mixed-Use Residential (up to 75 units per acre)", "Mixed-Use
- 7 Low-Intensity (8-30 units per acre), "Mixed-Use Medium-Intensity (12-30 units per acre)",
- 8 "Office", "Commercial", "Education", "Public Facilities", "Conservation", and "Planned Use
- 9 District", as shown on Exhibit "A", to the land use categories of "Urban Mixed-Use 1 (UMU-1:
- 10 Up to 75 units/acre)" and "Urban Mixed-Use 2 (UMU-2: Up to 100 units/acre)", as shown on
- 11 Exhibit "B."
- 12 (See Maps attached hereto as Exhibits "A" and "B" and made a part
- hereof as if set forth in full.)

- Section 2. The City Manager is authorized and directed to make the necessary changes in
- maps and other data in the City of Gainesville 2000-2010 Comprehensive Plan, or element, or
- 17 portion thereof in order to comply with this ordinance.
- Section 3. If any section, sentence, clause or phrase of this ordinance is held to be invalid
- or unconstitutional by any court of competent jurisdiction then said holding shall in no way affect
- 20 the validity of the remaining portions of this ordinance.
- Section 4. All ordinances, or parts of ordinances, in conflict herewith are to the extent of
- 22 such conflict hereby repealed.

- Section 5. This ordinance shall become effective immediately upon passage on second reading; however, the effective date of this plan amendment shall be the date a final order is issued by the Department of Community Affairs finding the amendment to be in compliance in accordance
- 4 with Chapter 163.3184, F.S.; or the date a final order is issued by the Administration Commission
- 5 finding the amendment to be in compliance in accordance with Chapter 163.3184, F.S.

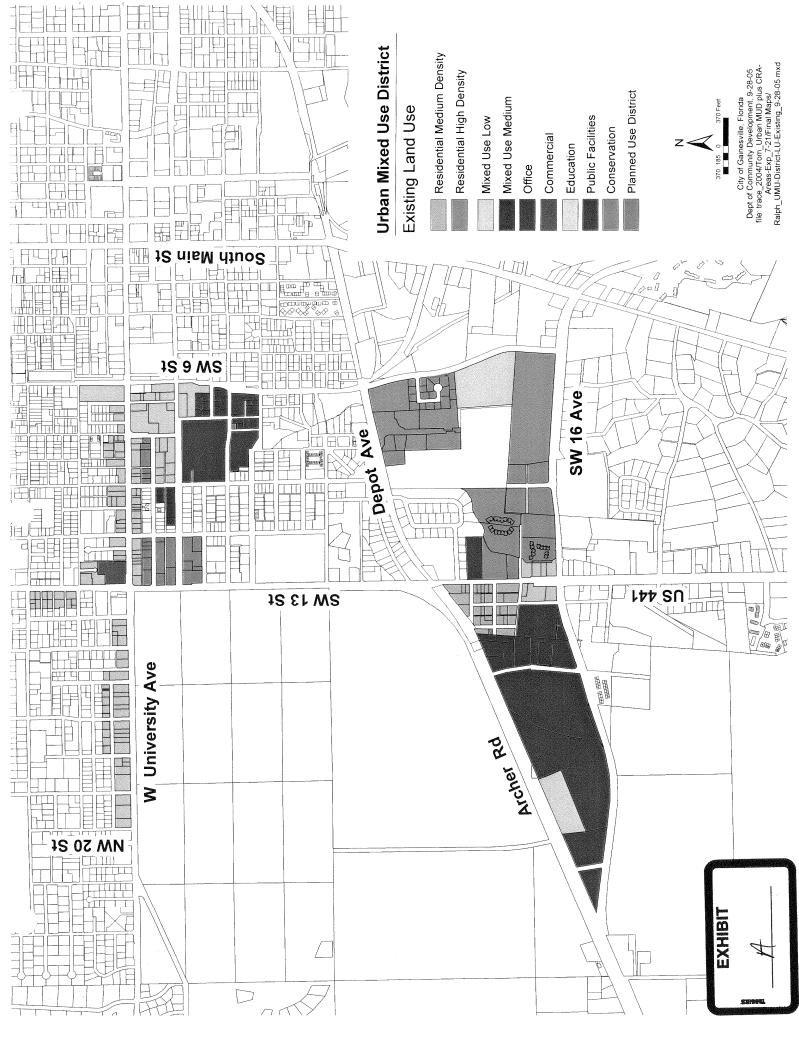

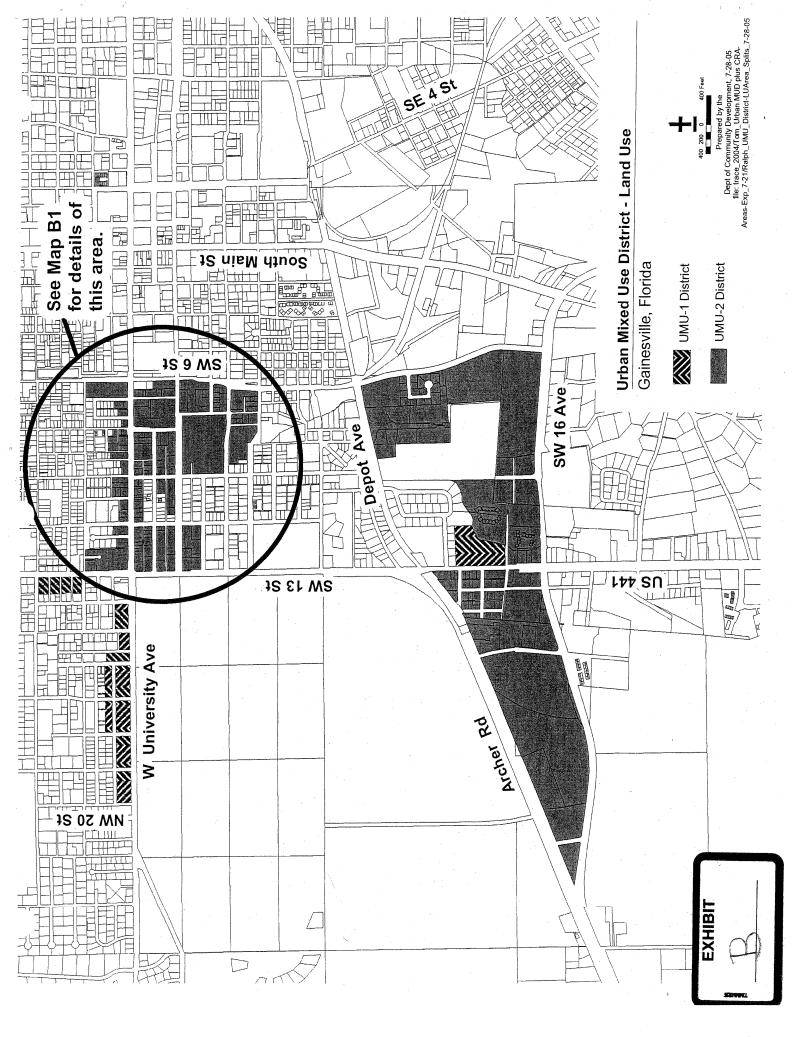

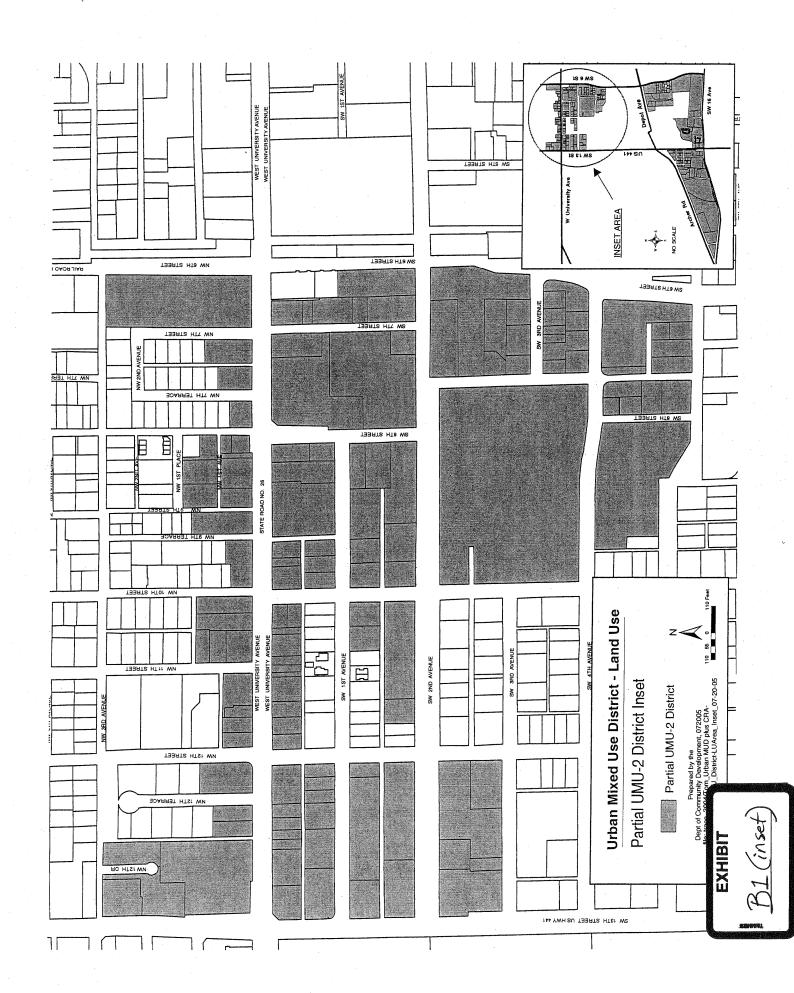
