A Resolution of the City Commission of the City of Gainesville, Florida supporting the naming of that portion of S.W. 23<sup>rd</sup> Street, in front of James G. Pressley Stadium and 4211 SW 23<sup>rd</sup> Street, between S.W. 2<sup>nd</sup> Avenue and Fraternity Row/Drive in Alachua County, located on the University of Florida campus, as "Coach Jimmy Carnes Boulevard."

WHEREAS, Jimmy Carnes was a longtime resident with a distinguished career in business and track and field;

WHEREAS, Jimmy Carnes led a life dedicated to the advancement of amateur sports with significant prestige for the State of Florida with the creation of the Sunshine State Games where over 100,000 athletes have participated in this summer amateur competition; and,

WHEREAS, the State of Florida CS/HB 7039, codified as Chapter 2012-228, Laws of Florida, has authorized the area designated as: That portion of SW 23<sup>rd</sup> Street, in front of James G. Pressly Stadium and 4211 SW 23<sup>rd</sup> Street, between SW 2<sup>nd</sup> Avenue and Fraternity Row/Drive in Gainesville, Alachua County be designated as "Coach Jimmy Carnes Boulevard."

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF GAINESVILLE, FLORIDA:

- Supports the Gainesville Sports Commission's request and Chapter 2012-228, Laws of Florida, to have that portion of SW 23rd Street, in front of James G. Pressly Stadium and 4211 SW 23rd Street, between SW 2nd Avenue and Fraternity Row/Drive in Gainesville, Alachua County be designated as "Coach Jimmy Carnes Boulevard."
