7	finding that the conditions in a certain area adjacent to the existing Eastside		
8	Community Redevelopment Area of the City of Gainesville, as more		
9	specifically described in this Resolution, constitutes blight, and that the		
10	rehabilitation, conservation, redevelopment, or combination thereof of such area is necessary in the interest of the public health, safety, morals or welfare of the residents of the City, and providing an immediate effective data

13	of the residents of the City; and providing an immediate effective date.		
14			
15	WHEREAS, on February 18, 2010, the City Commission of the City of Gainesville		
16	considered the expansion of the Eastside Community Redevelopment Area to the South and East		
17	and requested the City Manager to include in budget deliberations funding a blight findings		
18	study in the FY11 and/or FY12 budget; and		
19	WHEREAS, on July 20, 2010, the City Commission approved the funding for the blight		
20	findings study in the FY11 budget; and		
21	WHEREAS, on February 3, 2011, the City entered into a contract with WilsonMiller		
22	Stantec to prepare a study to determine whether a certain area of the City was a "slum" or		
23	"blighted" area and therefore eligible for inclusion in the Eastside Community Redevelopment		
24	Area; and		
25	WHEREAS, the study has been completed and concludes that the property as more		
26	particularly shown and described on Exhibits 1 and 2 (the "Area"), is a "blighted" area in which		
27	there are a substantial number of deteriorated or deteriorating structures in which conditions		
28	exist that are leading to economic distress or endanger life or property, as indicated by the		
29	presence of certain documented factors;		

1	NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE		
2	CITY OF GAINESVILLE, FLORIDA:		
3	Section 1. That the study entitled City of Gainesville Eastside CRA Expansion Area		
4	Analysis - "Finding of Necessity" dated August 2011 ("Report"), prepared for the City of		
5	Gainesville by WilsonMiller Stantec, a copy of which is on file in the office of the Clerk of the		
6	Commission, is adopted by reference and incorporated herein as if set forth in full.		
7	Section 2. That based on the information and statistics contained in the aforesaid Report,		
8	and other information presented to the City Commission, the City Commission finds that the		
9	Area, as more particularly shown and described in Exhibits 1 and 2 attached to this Resolution		
10	and in the Report, is a blighted area in which there are substantial number of deteriorated or		
11	deteriorating structures, in which conditions, as indicated by government-maintained statistics or		
12	other studies, are leading to economic distress or endanger life or property, and in which the		
. 13	following factors are present:		
14	(a) Unsanitary and unsafe conditions, including properties with poor upkeep		
15	and potential safety issues and public dumping. In addition, code violations, per		
16	parcel, that are in excess of the City of Gainesville average;		
17	(b) Deterioration of site or other improvements;		
18	(c) Inadequate and outdated building density patterns; and,		
19	(d) Diversity of ownership or defective or unusual conditions of title which		
20	prevent the free alienability of land within the deteriorated or hazardous area.		
21	Section 3. That the rehabilitation, conservation, or redevelopment, or a combination		
22	thereof, of the Area is necessary in the interest of the public health, safety, morals, or welfare of		
23	the residents of the City of Gainesville.		

1	Section 4. This resolution shall tal	ke effect immediately upon adoption.
