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### **ORDINANCE NO. 110814**

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An ordinance amending the Future Land Use Map of the City of Gainesville Comprehensive Plan by changing the land use category of approximately 24.7 acres of property located in the vicinity of 2000 SW 43rd Street, as more specifically described in this ordinance, from the Alachua County land use category of Recreation to the City of Gainesville land use categories of Recreation (REC), Conservation (CON), and Public Facilities (PF); providing directions to the City Manager; providing a severability clause; providing a repealing clause; and providing an effective date.

WHEREAS, notice was given as required by law that the Future Land Use Map of the City of Gainesville Comprehensive Plan be amended by changing the land use category of certain property, as more specifically described in this ordinance, from the Alachua County land use category of Recreation (REC) to the City of Gainesville land use categories of Recreation (REC), Conservation (CON), and Public Facilities (PF); and

WHEREAS, notice was given and publication was made as required by law and public hearings were held by the City Plan Board on February 23, 2012, and by the City Commission on April 19, 2012; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to law, an advertisement no less than two columns wide by 10 inches long was placed in a newspaper of general circulation notifying the public of this proposed ordinance and of the public hearing to be held in the City Commission meeting room, First Floor, City Hall, in the City of Gainesville at least seven (7) days after the day the first advertisement was published; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to law, after the public hearing at the transmittal stage, the City of Gainesville transmitted copies of this proposed amendment to the reviewing agencies and any other local government unit or state agency that requested same; and

WHEREAS, a second advertisement no less than two columns wide by 10 inches long was

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1	placed in the aforesaid newspaper notifying the public of the second public hearing to be held at the
2	adoption stage at least five (5) days after the day the second advertisement was published; and
3	WHEREAS, public hearings were held pursuant to the published notices described above
4	at which hearings the parties in interest and all others had an opportunity to be and were, in fact,
5	heard.
6	WHEREAS, prior to adoption of this ordinance the City Commission has considered any
7	written comments received concerning this amendment.
8	NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE
9	CITY OF GAINESVILLE, FLORIDA:
10	Section 1. The Future Land Use Map of the City of Gainesville Comprehensive Plan is
11	amended by changing the land use category of the following property from the Alachua County
12	land use category of Recreation (REC) to the City of Gainesville land use category of Recreation

See legal description attached hereto as Exhibit "C" and made a part hereof as if set forth in full. The location of the property is shown on Exhibit "D" for visual reference. In the event of conflict or inconsistency, Exhibit "C" shall prevail over Exhibit "D."

Section 4. Within 10 working days of the transmittal (first) hearing, the City Manager is authorized and directed to transmit a comprehensive plan amendment package, including this ordinance, to the reviewing agencies and to any other local government unit or state agency that has filed a written request for same with the City. Within 10 working days of the adoption (second) hearing, the City Manager is authorized and directed to transmit a comprehensive plan amendment package, including this ordinance, to the state land planning agency and to any other reviewing agency, local government unit or state agency that filed written comments with the City.

**Section 5.** The City Manager is authorized and directed to make the necessary changes in maps and other data in the City of Gainesville Comprehensive Plan in order to comply with this ordinance.

**Section 6.** If any word, phrase, clause, paragraph, section or provision of this ordinance or the application hereof to any person or circumstance is held invalid or unconstitutional, such finding shall not affect the other provisions or applications of this ordinance that can be given effect without the invalid or unconstitutional provisions or application, and to this end the provisions of this ordinance are declared severable.

- **Section 7.** All ordinances, or parts of ordinances, in conflict herewith are to the extent of such conflict hereby repealed.
- Section 8. This ordinance shall become effective immediately upon passage on second

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reading; however, the effective date of this plan amendment, if the amendment is not timely 1 2 challenged, shall be 31 days after the state land planning agency notifies the City that the plan amendment package is complete in accordance with Section 163.3184, F.S. If timely challenged, 3 this amendment shall become effective on the date the state land planning agency or the 4 Administration Commission enters a final order determining this adopted amendment to be in 5 6 compliance with Chapter 163, F.S. 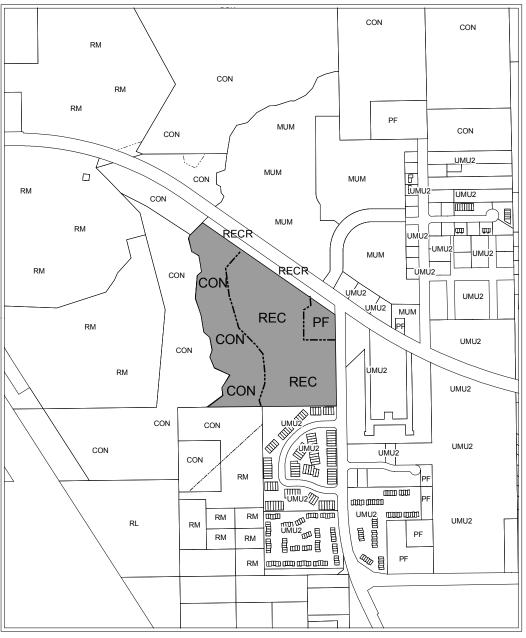
