4 **An ordinance of the City of Gainesville, Florida, amending Appendix A,**
5 **Schedule of Fees, Rates and Charges of the Code of Ordinances by revising**
6 **fees, rates and charges for the following: adult performance establishment,**
7 **escort service and escort licenses; alcoholic beverages; cable franchise;**
8 **cemetery; controlled vehicular parking area decals/permits; fire/rescue;**
9 **health and sanitation; home occupation permit; land development code;**
10 **parks, recreation and cultural affairs; peddlers, solicitors and canvassers;**
11 **registered domestic partnerships; secondhand goods; streets, sidewalks and**
12 **other public places; taxation; traffic and motor vehicles; and utilities relating**
13 **to solid waste and recyclables; providing directions to the codifier; providing**
14 **a severability clause; providing a repealing clause; and providing an effective**
15 **date.**

17 **WHEREAS,** at least ten (10) days' notice has been given once by publication in a
18 newspaper of general circulation notifying the public of this proposed ordinance and of the
19 public hearings in the City Hall Auditorium located on the first floor of City Hall in the City of
20 Gainesville; and

21 **WHEREAS,** public hearings were held pursuant to the published notice described above,
22 at which all interested parties had an opportunity to be, and were, in fact, heard.

23 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE**
24 **CITY OF GAINESVILLE, FLORIDA:**

25 **Section 1.** Portions of Appendix A of the Code of Ordinances, relating to fees, rates or
26 charges are amended as set forth in Exhibit "A," attached to this ordinance and incorporated by
27 reference as if fully set forth herein. Except as amended herein, the remainder of Appendix A
28 remains in full force and effect.

29 **Section 2.** It is the intention of the City Commission that the provisions of Section 1
30 shall become and be made a part of the Code of Ordinances of the City of Gainesville, Florida,
31 and that the Sections and Paragraphs of this Ordinance may be renumbered or relettered in order
32 to accomplish such intentions.


1 **Section 3.** If any word, phrase, clause, paragraph, section or provision of this ordinance
2 or the application hereof to any person or circumstance is held invalid or unconstitutional, such
3 finding shall not affect the other provisions or applications of the ordinance which can be given
4 effect without the invalid or unconstitutional provisions or application, and to this end the
5 provisions of this ordinance are declared severable.

6 **Section 4.** All ordinances, or parts of ordinances, in conflict herewith are to the extent of
7 such conflict hereby repealed.

8 **Section 5.** This ordinance shall take effect immediately upon adoption; provided
9 however the fees, rates and charges set forth herein shall be applicable to fees, rates and charges
10 which are due and payable after 12:01 AM on October 1, 2015, provided however, new fees,
11 rates and charges are not applicable to reservations of parks, recreational or cultural facilities, if
12 the reservation was booked prior to the effective date of this ordinance, in which case the City
13 will charge the fees, rates and charges in place at the time the reservation was booked.


