An ordinance of the City of Gainesville, Florida, amending section 2-391.1 of the Code of Ordinances related to notice requirements for the code enforcement process; deleting out-of-date notice provisions and providing that notice must comply with state law; providing directions to the codifier; providing a severability clause; providing a repealing clause;

and providing an immediate effective date.

Recommendation: The City Commission adopt the proposed ordinance.

At its meeting of April 10, 2000, the City Commission authorized the City Attorney to draft and the Clerk of the Commission to advertise an ordinance changing the service requirements for the code enforcement process, as provided in Chapter 162, Florida Statutes.

17	NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE
18	CITY OF GAINESVILLE, FLORIDA:
19	Section 1. Section 2-391.1 of the Code of Ordinances, City of Gainesville, is amended to
20	read as follows:
21	Sec. 2-391.1. Notices.
22	All notices required by this division shall comply with F.S. § 162.12.
23	(a) All notices required by this division shall be provided to the alleged violator by
24	certified mail, return receipt requested; by hand delivery by the sheriff or other law
25	enforcement officer, code inspector, or other person designated by the local governing
26	body; or by leaving the notice at the violator's usual place of residence with any person
27	residing therein who is above 15 years of age and informing such person of the contents
28	of the notice.

2	code enfo	reement board, notice may also be served by publication or posting, as follows:
3	(1)	Newspaper publication.
4		a. Such notices shall be published once during each week for four
5		consecutive weeks (four publications being sufficient) in a newspaper of
6		general circulation in the county where the code enforcement board is
7		located. The newspaper shall meet such requirements as are prescribed
8		under F.S. Ch. 50, for legal and official advertisements.
9		b. Proof of publication shall be made as provided in F.S. §§ 50.041

11	(2)	Posting of notice.
12		a. If there is no newspaper of general circulation in the county where
13		the code enforcement board is located, three copies of such notice shall be
14		posed for at least 28 days in three different and conspicuous places in such

17		b. Proof of posting shall be by affidavit of the person posting the
18		notice, which affidavit shall include a copy of the notice posted and the

22	rec	quired under subsection (a).
