2 3 4 5 6 7 8 9 10	An ordinance amending the Future Land Use Map of the City of Gainesville Comprehensive Plan by changing the land use category of approximately 0.89 acres of property generally located within the 1900 block of the north side of NW 53 rd Avenue and within the 1700 block of the south side of NW 53 rd Avenue, as more specifically described in this ordinance, from Office (O) and Commercial (C) to Public and Institutional Facilities (PF); providing directions to the City Manager; providing a severability clause; providing a repealing clause; and providing an effective date.
11 12	WHEREAS, notice was given as required by law that the Future Land Use Map of the
13	City of Gainesville Comprehensive Plan be amended by changing the land use category of the
14	property that is the subject of this ordinance from Office (O) and Commercial (C) to Public and
15	Institutional Facilities (PF); and
16	WHEREAS, the amendment to the Future Land Use Map of the City of Gainesville
17	Comprehensive Plan proposed herein involves a use of 10 acres or fewer and qualifies as a small-
18	scale development amendment as provided in Section 163.3187, Florida Statutes; and
19	WHEREAS, the City Plan Board, which acts as the local planning agency pursuant to
20	Section 163.3174, Florida Statutes, held a public hearing on September 25, 2014, and voted to
21	recommend that the City Commission adopt this ordinance; and
22	WHEREAS, at least five (5) days' notice has been given once by publication in a
23	newspaper of general circulation notifying the public of this proposed ordinance and of a public
24	hearing in the City Hall Auditorium located on the first floor of City Hall in the City of
25	Gainesville; and
26	WHEREAS, at least thirty (30) days' notice has been given by mail to each real property
27	owner whose land will be redesignated by enactment of this ordinance and whose address is

28 known by reference to the latest ad valorem tax records, notifying such property owners of this

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1	proposed ordinance and of a public hearing in the City Hall Auditorium located on the first floor
2	of City Hall in the City of Gainesville; and

- 3 WHEREAS, the public hearing was held pursuant to the notice described above at which
- 4 hearing the parties in interest and all others had an opportunity to be and were, in fact, heard.
- NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF GAINESVILLE, FLORIDA:
- Section 1. The Future Land Use Map of the City of Gainesville Comprehensive Plan is amended by changing the land use category of the following property from Office (O) and Commercial (C) to Public and Institutional Facilities (PF):
- See legal description attached as Exhibit "A" and made a part hereof as if set forth in full. The location of the property is shown on Exhibit "B" for visual reference. In the event of conflict or inconsistency, Exhibit "A" shall prevail over Exhibit "B". For informational purposes only, the existing land use categories are shown on Exhibit "C".

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- Section 2. The City Manager or designee is authorized and directed to make the necessary changes to maps and other data in the City of Gainesville Comprehensive Plan in order to comply with this ordinance.
- Section 3. If any word, phrase, clause, paragraph, section or provision of this ordinance or the application hereof to any person or circumstance is held invalid or unconstitutional, such finding shall not affect the other provisions or applications of this ordinance that can be given effect without the invalid or unconstitutional provision or application, and to this end the provisions of this ordinance are declared severable.
- Section 4. All ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict herewith are to the extent of such conflict hereby repealed on the effective date of this amendment to the Comprehensive Plan.

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	Section 5. This ordinance shall bec	ome effective immediately upon adoption; however
2	the effective date of this amendment to the	ne City of Gainesville Comprehensive Plan, if the
3	amendment is not timely challenged, shall be	be 31 days after adoption. If timely challenged, this
4	amendment shall become effective on t	he date the state land planning agency or the
5	Administration Commission enters a final or	der determining the amendment to be in compliance
6	with Chapter 163, Florida Statutes. No dev	elopment orders, development permits, or land uses
7	dependent on this amendment may be issued	d or commenced before this amendment has become
8	effective.

LEGAL DESCRIPTION FOR TAX PARCEL 07882-014-001

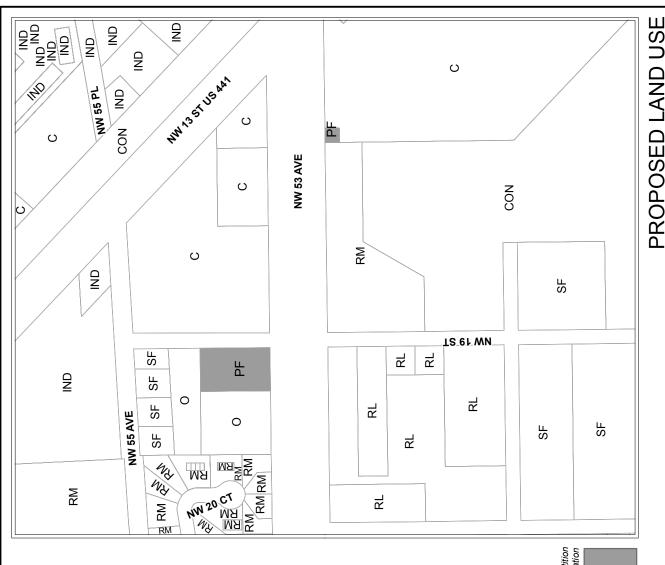

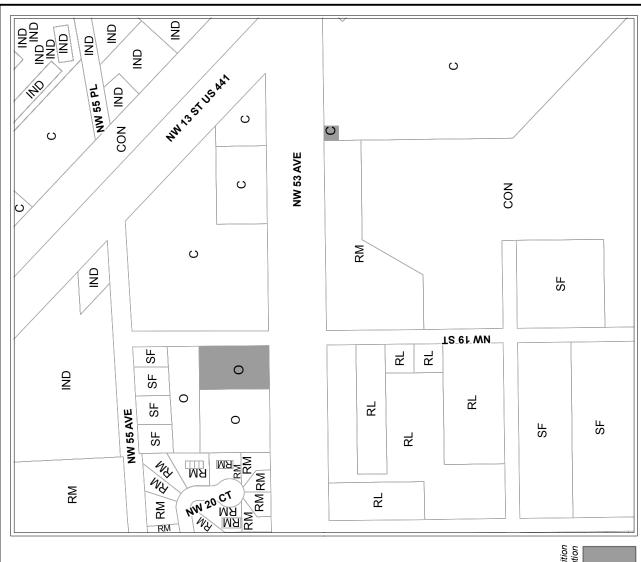
