WHEREAS, Dr. Cullen Wadsworth Banks II was the first African American to have full privileges at Alachua General Hospital and North Florida Regional Medical Center; and

WHEREAS, Dr. Cullen Wadsworth Banks II was a life member of the Florida Medical Association, life member of the Alachua County Medical Society and served on the Regional Health Planning Council as well as many other state and national medical related associations as well as a Founding Trustee of the North Florida Regional Medical Center.

WHEREAS, Dr. Cullen Wadsworth Banks II served as volunteer Doctor for Sickle Cell Foundation and volunteer Doctor for Acorn Clinic.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF GAINESVILLE, FLORIDA:

- SE 11 Avenue from SE 15 Street to Williston Road in the City of Gainesville, Florida, is designated and dual-named as "Dr. Cullen W. Banks II Boulevard" in his honor so his service to the Gainesville community will always be remembered.
- 2. The City Manager or designee is hereby authorized to carry out all necessary action to fulfill this Resolution.
- 3. This Resolution shall become effective immediately upon adoption.
