An ordinance of the City of Gainesville, Florida, amending Appendix A, section 3 of the Land Development Code, incorporating a specific change from Type IV (Civic) to Type I (Shop Front/Office/Apartment) for certain property located in the vicinity of 205 NW 14th Street as more specifically shown on the map of the College Park Special Area Plan; providing directions to the City Manager; providing a severability clause; providing a repealing clause; and providing an

immediate effective date.

<u>Recommendation</u>: The City Commission adopt the proposed ordinance.

#### COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT STAFF MEMORANDUM

This is an application to amend a portion of the College Park Special Area Plan Map, a 0.47-acre parcel from Type IV - Civic (civic uses) to Type I (shop fronts, offices, apartments or mixed-use buildings with apartments). As illustrated on the College Park Special Area Plan Map, the subject parcel is located at 205 Northwest 14<sup>th</sup> Street, between Northwest 2<sup>nd</sup> and 3<sup>rd</sup> Avenues, on the east side of Northwest 14<sup>th</sup> Street. The subject parcel contains a two-story boarding house/dormitory style residential building, which was formerly a place of religious assembly. The zoning and land use designations of the subject property and properties to the north and west are respectively RMU (Up to 75 units/acre, residential mixed use) and MUR (Mixed Use residential, up to 75 units per acre). The zoning and land use designations to the east (the only abutting property), south and northeast are respectively MU-1 (Mixed Use Low Intensity) and MUL (Mixed Use Low).

The existing Type IV - Civic classification is no longer appropriate for the subject property since the existing building is currently utilized solely as a residential structure. The requested change to Type - I (shop fronts, office, apartments or mixed-use buildings with apartments) will allow the mixed-use development proposed for the subject property and the remainder of the block located to the east.

The Plan Board heard the petition and recommended that it be approved.

Public notice was published in the Gainesville Sun on November 2, 2004. Letters were mailed to surrounding property owners on November 3, 2004. The Plan Board held a public hearing November 18, 2004.

The City Commission at its meeting on December 13, 2004, held a public hearing and approved Petition 162ZON-04 PB.

## **CITY ATTORNEY MEMORANDUM**

This ordinance requires two public hearings. Should the Commission adopt the ordinance on first reading, the second and final reading will be May 9, 2005.
