## **Recycling Processing**

- Alachua County was assigned the City's contract with S&P Recycling for processing recycling in 2015. This contract expires September 30, 2016.
- Alachua County has proposed a blended rate and potential revenue share which provides for Alachua County to absorb increased operating cost associated with the County's \$12 Living Wage Ordinance that goes into effect October 1, 2016.



#### **Solid Waste Disposal Agreements**

- Interlocal Agreement with Alachua
   County for Solid Waste Services
   Expires December 2018
- Interlocal Agreement between
   Alachua County and New River for
   Solid Waste Disposal
  - Expires December 2018



# Solid Waste Disposal





#### **Option A**

- Initiate contract negotiations with Alachua County to extend the Interlocal Agreement beyond 2018.
  - Considerations:
    - City has ability to influence the disposal option chosen by Alachua County.
    - City is provided assurances for a maximum tipping fee for the duration of the agreement



#### **Option B**

 Approve an Interlocal Agreement with Alachua County for processing recyclables for a term to expire in 2018 to coincide with the existing Interlocal Agreement with Alachua County for waste disposal.



#### **Option C**

 Establish one or more exclusive commercial franchises to control all waste in the City and protect the City's ability to negotiate processing and disposal services in the future.



#### **Option D**

 Hire a consultant to identify and evaluate the City's options of managing the collection and disposal of solid waste and recycling services.



#### **Staff Recommendation**

That the City obtain the services of a solid waste consultant to assist in evaluating the cost/benefit of solid waste management options.
