17	WHEREAS, the Alachua County Property Appraiser certified the 2007 taxable values to
18	the City Commission of the City of Gainesville, Florida on June 28, 2007.
19	WHEREAS, Section 200.065, Florida Statutes, requires the City Commission to advise
20	the Property Appraiser of its rolled-back millage rate, its proposed millage rate, and of the time,
21	date, and place at which a public hearing will be held to consider the proposed millage rate and
22	the proposed tentative budget.
23	NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE
24	CITY OF GAINESVILLE, FLORIDA:
25	Section 1. The rolled-back millage rate for the general municipal purpose, as computed
26	pursuant to Section 200.065 (1), Florida Statutes, is 4.3860 mills.
27	Section 2. The maximum millage rate authorized to be levied by a majority vote
28	pursuant to Section 200.185 (3)(a), Florida Statutes, is 4.2544 mills.
29	Section 3. The proposed millage rate necessary to fund the proposed tentative general
30	purpose municipal budget for the City of Gainesville's 2007-2008 fiscal year is mills.

1	Section 4. A public hearing will be held to consider the proposed millage rate and the
2	proposed tentative budget for general municipal purposes on Monday, September 10, 2007, at six
3	o'clock p.m., or as soon thereafter as the matter may be heard, in the City Hall Auditorium on the
4	first floor of City Hall, 200 East University Avenue, City of Gainesville, Florida.
5	Section 5. The City Manager is hereby authorized and directed to provide a copy of this
6	resolution to the Alachua County Property Appraiser for use in preparing the Notice of Proposec
7	Property Taxes, as required by Section 200.069, Florida Statutes, and to execute, as the
8	Administering Official, any Department of Revenue forms necessary to complete this
9	certification.
10	Section 6. This resolution shall take effect immediately upon its adoption.
