# SW 5<sup>th</sup> AVENUE TRIANGLE PROJECT

#### INTRODUCTION

- The SW 5<sup>th</sup> Avenue Triangle is located at the corner of SW 13<sup>th</sup> Street and SW 5<sup>th</sup> Avenue.
- A Partnership between the University of Florida, the City of Gainesville and Gainesville Community Redevelopment Agency.
- The University of Florida owns 50 percent of the triangle and approximately 50 percent is owned by the City of Gainesville.


## INTRODUCTION CONTINUED


- The CP/UH Advisory Board wanted to create a urban pocket park and a gateway to the University Heights Neighborhood.
- Two University of Florida Committees, the CP/UH Advisory Board and the CRA have reviewed the final landscaping plans and public art prior to granting approval.

#### **DESIGN**

- Landscape Architect Buford Davis created a design which includes brick pavers/ hardscaping, pedestrian scale lighting, sidewalk relocation and alignment, benches and landscaping.
- Anglin Construction Co. won the bid to construct the project through the City's Public Works Division.
