



<p><b>APPLICATION:</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- The trail is widened to 12 ft wide.</li> <li>- Two rest-stop areas are added within this segment, located approximately every 1.8 mile, to include benches and trash receptacles and designed as shown within the guidelines.</li> <li>- This segment is landscaped with canopy and understory trees and groundcover of types listed within the guidelines. Tree plantings are located outside of the utility easement areas along the trail. Trees are grouped around rest stops and clustered at key view points along the trail.</li> </ul>	<p><b>Signs are added along the trail corridor.</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Trail stop and warning signs and roadway warning signs alert both trail users and drivers of the trail crossing</li> <li>• Directional signs at intersecting walks orient those entering the trail</li> <li>• A gateway sign welcomes trail users</li> <li>• Environmental education signs, focusing on native ecology/ flora and fauna, are located near rest stops for best use</li> <li>• Mile marker signs are located based on the Depot Ave. trail overall</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Pedestrian lights are installed 80-100 ft. on center. Lighting levels will be maintained at a level to illuminate trail edges. These lights will be remain on throughout the night.</li> <li>• The trail intersection with SW 11th Street is rebuilt to the low-speed roadway-trail crossing standards within the guidelines.</li> <li>• New walk connections are provided by new developments along the trail.</li> <li>• All improvements to abide by accepted College Park/University Heights CRA District guidelines and City of Gainesville codes.</li> </ul>
