15	providing increased flexibility in its personnel management system, and by assisting in the
16	attraction and retention of competent personnel; and
17	WHEREAS, the City of Gainesville has determined that permitting participants in
18	the Plan to obtain loans from the Plan under certain circumstances will serve these
19	objectives;
20	NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COMMISSION
21	OF THE CITY OF GAINESVILLE, FLORIDA:
22	Section 1. The Plan will permit loans solely for the purpose of allowing employees
23	described in Section 2-523(i) of the City of Gainesville Code of Ordinances to utilize the
24	entire amount of any such loan to "purchase" additional credited service in the General
25	Employees Pension Plan of the City of Gainesville, in accordance with the terms of Section
26	2-523(i).
27	Section 2. The Plan Administrator is hereby authorized to execute appropriate
28	documents necessary to implement Section 1, and to otherwise administer the loan
29	program authorized hereunder.

1	Section 3. All resolutions, or parts of resolutions, in conflict herewith are to the
2	extent of such conflict hereby repealed.
3	Section 4. This Resolution shall become effective immediately upon adoption.
