120705. Facilitate Broader Community Support to Improve the Educational Opportunities for City Youth (B)

Comm. Hinson-Rawls gave a presentation of her visit at the Racial Equity Conference in Minneapolis, MN beginning with showing a video "Convening on Racial Equity". Comm. Hinson-Rawls provided specific information relative to the City's Fire Chief and Human Resources Director. She explained via video Minneapolis' Urban Scholars Program pointing out St. Paul's youth academy is similar to our fire academy.
