University of Florida/Institute of Food and Agricultural Sciences, February 2018 - Present

The research program focuses on participatory action research in agricultural research and how to increase consumer awareness and involvement in agricultural research. In this capacity, I act as a pre-award liaison for Dr. Swisher's research proposals, developing proposal budgets and working closely with our grant specialist through the proposal submission process. I provide post-award support for Dr. Swisher by managing budgets and expenses for all projects (10+), submitting no-cost extensions, writing annual reports, managing travel and purchasing, tracking project deliverables, managing UF Institutional Review Board submissions for human subjects research, and managing participant compensation. Working together with Dr. Swisher and her graduate students, we develop research materials, conduct research activities, monitor and evaluate extension programs and research activities, coordinate project team and committee meetings, and edit and prepare publications, presentations, reports, theses, and dissertations. I work directly with stakeholders and local farmers to conduct needs assessments, develop extension in-service trainings, identify gaps in research, and develop grant proposals. I also manage our UF Center for Sustainable and Organic Food Systems website.

Florida Sustainable Agriculture Research and Education (SARE) Program Assistant

University of Florida/Institute of Food and Agricultural Sciences, January 2016 - Present

The Florida SARE program works with state leaders from the University of Florida (UF) and Florida Agricultural and Mechanical University (FAMU) in developing and coordinating statewide training activities. I am responsible for working with the advisory council, coordinating and organizing training workshops, educational programs, and other professional development related activities by contacting and communicating with guest speakers, handling promotion and announcing of professional development activities and other sustainable agriculture educational opportunities. I lead several in-service trainings on grant writing, using a

theory of change, when to use the UF Institutional Review Board (IRB) in extension programming, business retention and expansion, and the graduate student grant writing workshops offered to UF and FAMU graduate students each spring. I also develop and administer our training program evaluations, write the SARE annual reports, and assist the state leaders in fulfilling the model state program objectives. Due to COVID-19, we are working remotely and are in the process of transitioning some of our current trainings and developing new trainings for online delivery. We will launch our virtual trainings throughout 2021.
