- 1) Advertising three vacancies and whether they should have qualifications from the existing criteria set forth by ordinance or just open it to any candidate and assess the qualifications of those in the pool;
- 2) Whether to modify the existing criteria for the categories of membership;
- 3) How to assess whether applicants/members have a conflict of interest and how they should make a financial disclosure.

Member Selvester made a motion that Dr. Denslow be moved to the at-large position to solve the at-large problem and that the intent was to represent large business which meant corporate signer. Motion passed unanimously.

The discussion of whether to change the criteria for the different categories of board membership was deferred and will be discussed at the Board's January 23, 2017, workshop.

Regarding whether board members should be required to complete financial disclosure and conflict of interest forms, Member Orlando made a motion that the Board follow the state statute on advisory boards. The motion was seconded by Member Alford and passed unanimously.
