

**Resolution No. 070407**

**A Resolution of the City Commission of the City of  
Gainesville, Florida, to designate and dual-name N.W.  
19<sup>th</sup> Lane as "Christopher Neiberger Lane."**

**WHEREAS**, Christopher Todd Neiberger, a graduate of Gainesville High School and beloved resident of the City of Gainesville, enlisted in the Army in 2005 in order to serve his Country; and

**WHEREAS**, Army Specialist Neiberger was a member of the Army 1<sup>st</sup> Battalion, 18<sup>th</sup> Infantry Regiment, 2<sup>nd</sup> Brigade Combat Team, 1<sup>st</sup> Infantry Division stationed in Schweinfurt, Germany; and

**WHEREAS**, Army Specialist Neiberger was deployed to Iraq in September of 2006 for a fifteen-month tour as part of Operation Iraqi Freedom; and

**WHEREAS**, on August 6, 2007, Christopher lost his life fighting for his Country; and;

**WHEREAS**, Christopher was very active in his community and his compassion for others, love for his family, and camaraderie with his fellow soldiers will not be forgotten; and

**WHEREAS**, the City of Gainesville would like to honor his memory.

**NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE  
CITY OF GAINESVILLE, FLORIDA:**

**Section 1.** Northwest 19<sup>th</sup> Lane, which borders Gainesville High School, is hereby designated and dual-named "Christopher Neiberger Lane" in honor of Army Spc. Christopher Todd Neiberger.


**Section 2.** The City Manager or his designee is hereby authorized to carry out all necessary actions necessary to fulfill this Resolution.
