3. This Resolution shall become effective immediately upon adoption.





Pursuant to section 9-14.1, Code of Ordinances, City of Gainesville, I hereby certify the following results of the election for the Charter Amendment:

PARKS AND RECREATION AREAS

“CURRENTLY THE CITY CHARTER DOES NOT ALLOW SPENDING ANY FEDERAL, STATE OR LOCAL MONIES TO PAVE FOR TRANSPORTATION PURPOSES OR RECREATIONAL FACILITIES IN CONSERVATION OR RECREATION AREAS WITHIN THE HOGTOWN CREEK WATERSHED (WATERSHED). SHOULD THE CITY CHARTER BE AMENDED TO ALLOW PAVING FOR PARKING OR RECREATIONAL FACILITIES ON RECREATION AREAS (PARKS), AS PROVIDED IN ORDINANCE 041138, WHILE CONTINUING TO PROHIBIT PAVING FOR TRAILS OR TRANSPORTATION CORRIDORS ON CITY-OWNED PROPERTY DESIGNATED CONSERVATION WITHIN THE WATERSHED?”
