PROCLAMATION

WHEREAS, the annual Great American Cleanup Day in Alachua County coordinated by Keep Alachua County Beautiful will be observed April 21, 2001; and

WHEREAS, Publix, Keep Florida Beautiful, the City of Gainesville, Alachua County, the Gainesville Sun, KJK 98.5 FM Boone Waste Management, Inc. of Florida, WUFT-TV, Sam's Club, The Sky 97.3 FM SWS, Florence Landfill and Pepsi sponsor the Cleanup along with many, many other contributors; and

WHEREAS, last year 6,487 volunteers representing 156 groups picked up 212 tons of trash and recyclables with a fiscal benefit to the community of \$341,472.55; and

WHEREAS, there were lasting reminder projects such as trees, shrubs and flowers planted, homes cleaned, painted and landscaped, illegal dumps cleaned up and permanently cordoned off, bridges and walls painted, and graffiti removed; and
