CITY IMMEDIATE NEXT STEPS ON THE CHALLENGE

SUBMIT THE FOLLOWING:

- The city's existing EERE plan
- Short memo from the sustainability director including:
- City's progress vs. GCGC draft process
- Where are you on the process? What stage do you need the assistance?
- Chosen policy support mechanism
- PACE, Public Agency, On-Bill Financing
- Funding options identified
- Program expectations
- What is the potential of the program? eg Define success of this process in concrete terms (eg % of buildings retrofitted tied to energy efficiency targets)
- Under what timeframe are the city's targets defined?
- Preferred wave
- Submit within 45 days (by April 2, 2010) for inclusion in the 'first wave'

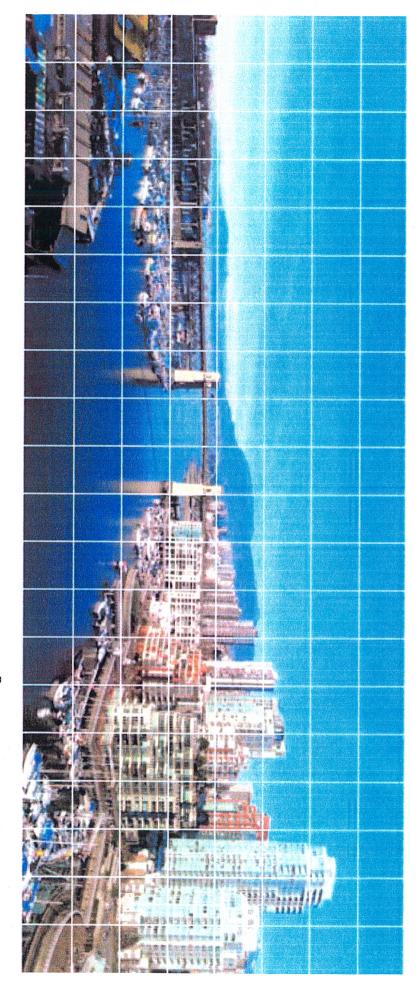

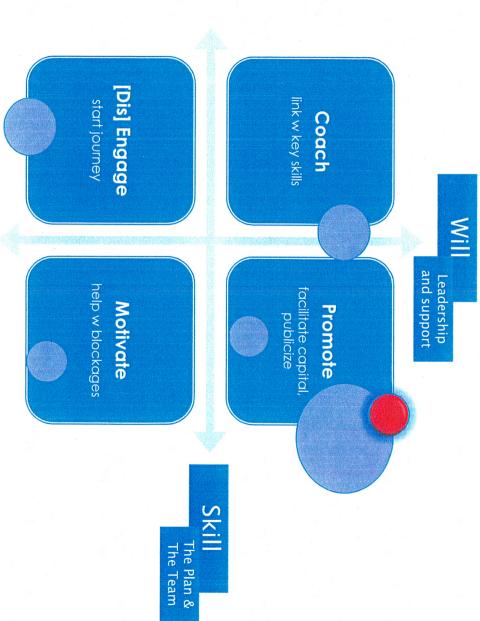
