THIS AGREEMENT, made and entered into this day of	, by

WITNESSETH

WHEREAS, the DEPARTMENT is preparing to undertake a project which is known as the retention pond enhancement project on the west end of State Road 26A behind the City of Gainesville Fire Station in Alachua County, Florida, Financial Project ID: 207790-1-52-01, which will be of benefit to the AGENCY; and

WHEREAS, the project requires agreement by the AGENCY to maintain the project which includes retention pond completion including fountain, lighting, street furniture, landscaping, sidewalks and all pertinent items associated with the project.

- B. Grass, Landscape and Irrigation for the median between 36th Street and 36th Drive; \$45,500.00
- C. Lighting; \$275,000.00
- D. Street furniture; \$8,000.00
- 2. Upon completion and acceptance the AGENCY will assume responsibility for maintenance of all items of enhancement.
- 3. To the extent permitted by law, the AGENCY shall indemnify, defend, save and hold harmless the DEPARTMENT and all its officers, agents, or employees from all suits, actions, claims, demands, liability of any nature whatsoever arising out of, because, or due to breach of this agreement by the AGENCY, its subcontractor, agents or employees, or due to any negligent act, or occurrence of omission of commission of the AGENCY, its subcontractors, agents or employees. Neither the AGENCY nor any

of its agents will be liable under this section for damages arising out of injury or damages to persons or property directly caused or resulting from the sole negligence of the DEPARTMENT or any of its officers, agents, or employees.
