15 16	WHEREAS, on July 26, 2010, the City Commission of the City of Gainesville, Florida
17	adopted Resolution No. 100192 which approved a Proposed Tentative General Government
18	Financial and Operating Plan Budget for the City of Gainesville, Florida; and
19	WHEREAS, on July 26, 2010, the City Commission adopted Resolution No. 100191
20	approving the proposed millage rate necessary to fund the Proposed Tentative General
21	Government Financial and Operating Plan Budget; and
22	WHEREAS, pursuant to law and utilizing the rate established in the said resolution on or
23	about August 24, 2010, the Alachua County Property Appraiser mailed a Notice of Proposed
24	Property Taxes to each taxpayer listed on the current year's assessment roll; and
25	WHEREAS, the said Notice of Proposed Property Taxes advised the recipients of a
26	public hearing to be conducted by the City Commission for consideration of its Amended
27	Tentative General Government Financial and Operating Plan Budget and the proposed millage
28	necessary to fund the said budget; and
29	WHEREAS, the public hearing has been held as specified in the Notice of Proposed
30	Property Taxes and in accordance with applicable law;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE
CITY OF GAINESVILLE, FLORIDA:
Section 1. The proposed operating millage rate of 4.2544 mills to fund the Amended
Tentative General Government Financial and Operating Plan Budget for the City of Gainesville's
2010-2011 fiscal year is hereby approved for further consideration in accordance with applicable
law.
Section 2. The General Fund operating millage rate approved herein is less than the
rolled-back rate of 4.7002 by 0.4458 mill, which results in a 9.48% decrease in property taxes.
Section 3. A public hearing will be held to consider the final millage rate and budget for
general municipal purpose on Thursday, the 16 <sup>th</sup> day of September, 2010, at 6:00 p.m. or as
soon thereafter as the matter may be heard in the City Hall Auditorium on the first floor of City
Hall, 200 East University Avenue, Gainesville, Florida.
Section 4. The City Manager is hereby authorized and directed to prepare and publish all
necessary and required notices prior to the hearing established herein, and to provide a copy of
this resolution to all parties as may be required by law.
<b>Section 4.</b> This resolution shall take effect immediately upon its adoption.
