PROCLAMATION

WHEREAS, the week ending with Thanksgiving Day is designated as Farm-City Week as a reminder to both farmer and consumer of the shared need for good relations with each other and to cause all citizens to examine and reflect on that mutual need.

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Pegeen Hanrahan, by the authority vested in me as Mayor of the City of Gainesville, do hereby proclaim November 18-25, 2005 as
